Florida Governor Ron DeSantis; Senator Marco Rubio; Attorney General Ashley Moody; Chief Financial Officer Jimmy Patronis; U.S. Congressmen Neal Dunn (District 2), Bill Posey (District 8), Greg Steube (District 17), and District 20 candidate Drew-Montez Clark; State Senator Tom Wright; and State Representative Randy Fine had no Republican opposition in the August 23 Primary Election, so they were not on the ballot, but they will face Democrat opponents on November 8.

No one at all challenged **State Senator Debbie Mayfield** and **State Representatives Tyler Sirois** and **Thad Altman.** so they have already been elected.

Running statewide for the position of Commissioner of Agriculture, former **Florida Senate President Wilton Simpson** won the Republican nomination.

All of the current Florida House of Representatives on the ballot in their respective districts won their primaries: Matt Gaetz (District 1), Kat Cammack (District 3), John Rutherford (District 5), Michael Waltz (District 6), Daniel Webster (District 11), Gus Bilarakis (District 12), Vern Buchanan (District 16), Scott Franklin (District 18), Byron Donalds (District 19), Brian Mast (District 21), Mario Diaz-Balart (District 26), Maria Salazar (District 27) and Carlos Gimenez (District 28).

Other successful Republicans on Congressional ballots who will face Democrat opponents in November are **Aaron Bean** (District 4), **Cory Mills** (District 7), **Scotty Moore** (District 9), **Calvin Wimbish** (District 10), **Anna Luna** (District 13), **James Judge** (District 14), **Laurel Lee** (District 15), **Dan Franzese** (District 22), **Joe Budd** (District 23), **Jesus Navarro** (District 24), and **Carla Spaulding** (District 25).

In State Representatives races, **Chase Tramont** won the District 30 Republican primary, and Robert **Brackett** was successful in District 34.

**Tom Goodson** won the Republican primary for Seat 2 on the Brevard County Commission, and **Rob Feltner** was successful in the District 4 race.

In the non-partisan judicial races, where party affiliations are not listed, Circuit Judge Jessica Recksiedler and County

**Judge Kelly Ingram** both won re-election to their posts, while a new County Judge position will be determined on November 8, between **Renee Torpy** and second-place finisher **Kimberly Musselman**, since no one reached the 50-percent mark in their race.

But it was the contests in the non-partisan Brevard School Board that brought the most joy to Republicans, as **Megan Wright** defeated a liberal incumbent in District 1, **Gene Trent** came in second to earn a runoff against the liberal candidate in District 2, and conservative **Kayte Campbell** won re-election in District 5.

#### DAYS IN THE LIFE OF FLORIDA GOVERNOR RON DESANTIS By Space Coast Tusk Editor Stuart Gorin



It has been a busy time for **Ron DeSantis** as he seeks a second term as Florida Governor this November.

Following the FBI raid on former President Donald Trump's home, DeSantis called it "yet another escalation in the

weaponization of federal agencies against the Regime's political opponents, while people like Hunter Biden get treated with kid gloves. And referring to the Biden Administration gaining an additional 87,000 IRS agents, the Governor said Democrats are not simply expanding an agency, "They are growing their army of Biden Regime soldiers standing ready to execute any order by the D.C. Swamp." He added, "These are not actions indicative of leaders in a free republic. This mirrors a Banana Republic."

Visiting Brevard County on August 3, he faced several hundred cheering supporters in Rockledge, as he appeared at a press conference along with government officials, medical personnel and first responders to announce a new opioid recovery program that will get underway in 12 Florida counties – Brevard included – to fight the crisis. This will be the first program of its kind in the nation, DeSantis said, pointing out that in Brevard County alone, there has been a 72 percent increase in drug overdose fatalities related to fentanyl being added to narcotic drugs, which victims often did not know.

He said the goal is for addicts to be treated and can move toward a drug-free future. The Governor promised to treat drug dealers peddling fentanyl harshly, by "going to jail for a long time." He blamed the Biden administration's "open southern border" for the flow of fentanyl across the country and in Florida.

"Substance abuse can affect any family at any time," DeSantis added, "so from education to law enforcement to treatment, we are going to make sure that Floridians can take advantage of this new addiction recovery model."

At his press conference, DeSantis also spotlighted the Biden administration's opposition to banning transgender athletes in amateur female sports, and he pointed to a Department of Agriculture policy tying its Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program to compliance with matters of sexual orientation and gender identity. "They're threatening to take away lunch money from poor kids as punishment from us protecting women's sports. Think about how deranged that is," DeSantis asserted.

Fox News host Jesse Watters quoted DeSantis as refusing to appear on the left-leaning ABC-TV show "The View," because he did not want to be the show's "tackling dummy." Appearing with Watters, DeSantis said his message to the ladies of "the View" is: "Sorry. You called me a murderer during COVID. You called me a traitor during the Russian hoax, and seven days of the week, you call me racist. And you're working with political prosecutors to put me in prison. Would any of us do well in prison? No....They are working in tandem with the Democrat Party. So I'm not going to be your tackling dummy for a rating. And they're not doing political journalism".

At a press conference in Hillsborough County, DeSantis announced he was suspending state attorney prosecutor Andrew Warren - who was backed by leftist billionaire George Soros – for neglect of duty by promising not to enforce state laws on abortion and child sex-change operations. "When you flagrantly violate your oath of office, when you make yourself above the law, you have violated your duty, you have neglected your duty, and you are displaying a lack of competence to be able to perform those duties," he said. DeSantis then appointed Hillsborough County Judge Susan Lopez to serve as Warren's replacement. Prosecutors backed by Soros, he said, were doing serious damage to cities and towns across America, adding, "they can't get these things enacted in a legislature where you're just going to let criminals run amok. So he will get involved in these Democrat primaries and a Democrat area, he'll flush a million dollars to get the radical to win the primary, then they usually win the general because of the party affiliation difference in the jurisdiction.... It's a total end run around our constitutional system. The results obviously have been destructive around the country. But it also really undermines the idea that ours is supposed to be a government of laws, not a government of individual men."

In yet another appointment, during a press conference in West Palm Beach, the Governor named **Palm Beach County Judge Renatha Francis,** a member of the Federalist Society, to the Florida State Supreme Court, replacing retiring **Justice Alan Lawson**.

Meanwhile, we have learned that in July, while DeSantis was delivering a speech at the "Moms For Liberty Summit" in Tampa, the organizer's account was frozen by PayPal. **Tina Descovich**, the group's co-founder, said she started getting emails during the speech that Pay Pal stopped processing all of their regular monthly donations. She said the woke tech giant's decision was "final – there is nothing you can do."

But just weeks later, Pay Pal reversed its decision and restored the account – after DeSantis announced in a press conference that in the 2023 legislative session, he would support a bill banning financial institutions from discriminating against Floridians based on their political views. He criticized woke financial platforms like PayPal imposing a Communist Chinese style social credit system to cut off anyone who opposes the Democrat Party from participating in society. DeSantis explained that no one elected woke CEOs and tech oligarchs to rule America.

For the Florida Governor, it was just another victory.



#### NATIONAL VETERANS HOMELESS SUPPORT HOLDS SUCCESSFUL FUNDRAISER

A sellout crowd of 500 supporters attended the National Veterans Homeless Support's 7<sup>th</sup> annual "Rescuing Veterans Lost in America Dinner" at the Radisson at the Port in Cape Canaveral August 12, raising tens of thousands of dollars through both open and silent auctions – funds that will be used to help combat homelessness among Florida's veterans.

George Taylor, Jr., who runs the NVHS, told the attendees he was "humbled by the coalition of concerned citizens; community leaders; military members; veterans; elected federal, state, county and city level officials; and law enforcement officers gathered to show solidarity for one thing: to end and prevent veteran homelessness in our community."



A single veteran who makes less than \$2,400 per month is considered to have "low income" in Brevard County, and "in poverty" if it is less than \$1,400 a month, Taylor said. According to the 2020 census, he added, "we had 4,600 veterans in poverty in the county at that time." There are challenges to be met, and "together, with our collective abilities and resources, there is no doubt we can," Taylor said. Showing a video of three veterans who have been assisted by NVHS, he said that while these cases were "fantastic enough," these stories were repeated 423 more times through the past year – support for veterans and their family members.

"Thanks to our partnerships, donors like you, and most importantly, my amazing team, we were ready," Taylor said." We did not need to turn away a veteran truly in need due to a wait list or a budgetary constraint."

He told the attendees their presence is "a testament to our community's dedication to ending and preventing veteran homelessness in Brevard."

Taylor has been in charge of NVHS since the 2020 passing of his father – **George Taylor**, **Sr.**, a veteran who founded the organization.

During the 2022 Florida Legislative Session, it was voted – and then signed by **Governor Ron DeSantis** – to rename a portion of State Road 520 in Cocoa – the location of NVHS headquarters – as "George Taylor, Sr. Memorial Highway." **State Senators Debbie Mayfield and Tom Wright** and **State Representative Tyler** 

**Sirois** presented Taylor, Jr. and other members of his family with a plaque at the dinner to commemorate the name change.

NVHS's Search and Rescue Mission is focused on helping homeless and at-risk veterans and their families get into housing if unsheltered or prevent them from becoming homeless if at-risk.

For unsheltered veterans, the team goes into the streets to locate them and provide such basic needs as food and outdoor gear. Then NVHS connects them to the Veterans Administration, housing agencies and benefits application specialists to get their medical needs addressed, housing, and to then Blickley be on a path to self-sufficiency.

For at-risk veterans, the organization reviews their financial and legal situation, works with landlords to pause evictions, helps them secure needed financial assistance, and works with pro-bono attorneys to resolve any legal issues that are preventing a stabilized life.

There were more than 130 veterans among the audience, and each one was asked to stand and state his or her name, branch of service, and when served. The largest applause was for retired **Major George Rosenfield**, who spoke briefly at the microphone about his service during World War II and the Korean War.



The Viera High School Army Junior ROTC Color Guard, organized by retired **Army Lieutenant Colonel Tim Thomas,** conducted the evening's opening exercises, as well as its annual enactment of the poignant "Missing Man Table," at which five empty chairs are placed – representing missing members of the five branches

of the U.S. military in armed conflict.

Thomas explained that the table's white cloth symbolizes the pure intentions of the service members who responded to the country's call to arms; a single rose in a vase represents the bloodshed in sacrifice as well as the family and friends who keep the faith while awaiting the return of the missing; a red ribbon represents a love of country that inspired the service members; a slice of lemon represents the bitter fate of the missing; sprinkled salt symbolizes the tears shed by waiting families; an inverted glass indicates that the missing and fallen cannot partake; a Bible represents the spiritual strength and faith to sustain the loss; and a lit candle symbolizes a light of hope that lives in hearts to illuminate the missing's way home.

Welcoming the audience to the event, Brevard County Property Appraiser Dana Blickley pointed out that Florida's voters recognized the sacrifices made by America's brave soldiers by approving several property tax exemptions for qualifying veterans and their surviving spouses.



These included, Blickley said, total exemption of homestead property taxes for honorably discharged veterans with service-connected total and permanent disability or confinement to a wheelchair; a discount for veterans 65 and older with a combat-related disability; total exemption for the surviving spouse of a military veteran who died in the line of duty; and a \$5,000 property exemption for a service-connected disability of 10 percent or more.




Blickley, and the other four Brevard Constitutional Officers – Sheriff Wayne Ivey, Clerk of Court Rachael Sadoff, Tax Collector Lisa Cullen, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott – are all long-time supporters of NVHS.

Ivey – who said that "while we may have our ups and downs, we are still the greatest country in the world" – served as auctioneer for the event, pitting attendees against one another to raise as much funds as possible for NVHS to carry out its mission.

Students – Si; Veterans – No!





In 2021, research found that 30,177 active duty personnel and veterans who served in the military after 9/11 have died by suicide. And unconfirmed reports say 50,000 or more Vietnam veterans have committed suicide.

A close personal friend has PTSD and a 50 percent disability. We live in a suburb of Atlanta. He has to see a psychiatrist for medication and a counselor for support. Over the past 2 years, all the psychiatrists at the VA clinic have resigned, with none being replaced. My friend now gets his meds through a nurse practitioner. His counselor was moved to another position. The counselor has not been replaced.

I also have a 50 percent disability. I needed to see my primary care VA doctor. It took a month to get an appointment. I needed to see the VA ophthalmologist. There's a 4 month waiting list and veterans can only see the ophthalmologist

once every 2 years. When the disability was awarded, the estimated monthly amount was figured in error. Their solution – reduce the monthly amount the VA mistakenly determined until the overpayments in disbursements is repaid because of their error.

What is this administration's solution to the veteran problem? Take between \$300 billion and \$500 billion, and some models estimate over \$1 trillion and forgive student loans! Veterans, what veterans?

When we enlisted, our contract was for years of our lives with the return to us of Veterans Benefits. Some paid with their lives while on active duty, others paid with their physical and mental disabilities.

So let's spend billions on people who made a contract for student loans and forgive their debt. Veterans, what veterans?

The benefit to the students is \$10,000 for individuals who earn less than \$125,000 a year and for a family making less than \$250,000.

I was a Nassau County Police Officer. In order to take the test for that department, you need to have an associate degree or earn



one before being sworn in. To reach top pay an officer needs a bachelor's degree. I have two degrees and paid off my loans quickly. At the time I was hired we had to buy our own weapons, buy our own holsters and belt, buy our own nightstick and handcuffs.

#### Will I be reimbursed? NO!

My son paid off his student loans. Will he be included in this boondoggle? NO!

How about those who didn't go to college? What about those who went through trade schools? A friend went to real estate school in order to get a salesperson and then a broker's license. Will he be receiving the government's largess and be repaid for those schools? NO!

My father was a licensed electrician with his own electrical contractors business. He had to be licensed in all the communities in which he worked. The process was lengthy and expensive. He would have to take a week off to travel to the various areas to renew his licenses. He needed special tools and equipment for the business. If he were alive today, would he receive help from the government. You know the answer – NO!

There is a litany of problems in our nation. There are many who legitimately need help. There is a mental health crisis in this country. There is a serious crime wave making many blue cities look like the wild west. We have a self-inflicted energy crisis. Our economy is plummeting, and we are strapped with a generational inflation rate making some middle and low income earners with decisions on where to best spend their

money. Anti-Semitism, anti-Asian crimes are on a rise. We have a wide open boarder, with fentanyl flowing into the country; and gang members, smugglers and possible terrorists infiltrating the United States through that broken boarder.

So, by forgiving \$10,000 to \$20,000 in student loans is more important to this administration than fixing our real problems. When you or I sign a contract for large purchase loans most abide by that contract and make every effort to repay and live up to the contract we sign. We don't go to our neighbors and demand they help pay for our loans. But that is exactly what is happening with this presidential edict. We are all going to have to pay for the billions of dollars so that Joe Biden can tick off another campaign promise and watch him bow down to the extreme left in his party.

I heard him say that by doing this, we will be generating a \$50 billion infusion into our economy. I was never that great in math but simple arithmetic leaves me wondering where the rest of the \$300 billion to \$500 billion going to come from. That is a rhetorical question because we all know who will pay for this.

Even liberal MSNBC reports: "The plan, these experts say, will cost taxpayers and does nothing to solve the tough unaffordability issues that plague higher education in the U.S."

"There's a transfer of wealth from the society at large to people who borrowed to go to college right now," said Andrew Lautz, director of federal policy at the National Taxpayers Union. "That has consequences for consumers. It has consequences for taxpayers."



Lautz published an estimate that found Biden's plan could cost the average taxpayer more than \$2,000, based on the \$10,000 forgiveness per student loan borrower that had been touted.

And for me, the best part is the application for the student loan forgiveness will be available in October, just weeks before the midterm elections!!!

There is a parable we are familiar with that says "teach a man to fish, he eats for a lifetime..." The new version is "teach a man to fish and he'll eat for a lifetime. Give a man a fish and he'll vote for the man who gave him the fish."

While some, not all, of the former students applaud this plan, there are many, many millions who will see this for what it is – a bold-faced effort to buy votes.

RENDEZVOUS WITH REPUBLICAN WOMEN BY Jill Gentis, BFRW President

The Brevard Federated Republican Women monthly meeting on August 3 featured a presentation by **Rachael Sadoff**, Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller. One of the most important things she and her staff do to serve the Brevard community is to educate citizens about property fraud schemes and mail scams. Sadoff spoke about fraudulent



schemers who try to get citizens to pay for copies of deeds recorded in the county's Official Records. She said that images of many types of property records, such as mortgages, deeds, and certain court papers relating to real property, can be viewed online free of charge, purchased directly from her office, or viewed at any of the six branch locations. Some

records, however, may not be available due to protections under Florida law.

She also spoke about other forms of fraud, involving misrepresented or shoddy services and unscrupulous venders. It is imperative, she said, that we do basic research about the criminal and financial history of anyone selling us a service. She and **Brevard Sheriff Wayne Ivey** want you to check the ID of any service or repair person or contractor, especially those that you may hire and willingly admit into your home to look after a loved one. Always check with Sadoff's office and the Sheriff's office whenever dealing with any contractor to ensure that they are a legitimate business and that neither they nor their employees have engaged in nefarious or criminal activities.

**Dixie Riepl**, our PhD Education and Scholarship Chair, and her committee presented two outstanding high school graduates to receive the remaining two BFRW Scholarships. The Lillian Banks Scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, was awarded to **Morgan Bentley**, who will be attending Florida State to pursue a degree in Biology; and the \$1,000 BFRW Trade School Scholarship was awarded to **William Sullivan**, who will be attending Eastern Florida to pursue a degree in the Fire Fighter Program.

At the August 5 meeting of the Federated Republican Women in Action (FRWA), held at MeMaw's BBQ in Palm Bay, **Rick Lacey**, chairman of the Brevard Republican Executive Committee (BREC),

There are currently 63,000 more registered Republicans than Democrats in Brevard County, but voter turn-out is the key. The Republicans were at a disadvantage in August because there is no governor's race on the Republican ballot. However, there is a governor's race on the Democrat ballot, so members of their party were more likely to come out to vote for their preferred candidate. Lacey also stated that unfortunately, this made our school board candidates the underdogs.

Brevard County was the #2 county in the state with votes for both Ron DeSantis and Donald Trump. Lacey said he would like to see Brevard move up to #1 this November. He also announced that BREC will be holding its Lincoln-Reagan Dinner on September 7 at the Radisson Inn in Cape Canaveral. The guest speaker will be **Colorado Congresswoman Lauren Boebert.** 

Also speaking at our meeting was **Grace Glass**, Brevard representative for the Desantis' re-election campaign, and **Caron McCullough**, Brevard Election Integrity coordinator with the Republican Party of Florida (RPOF).

Palm Bay City Councilman Pete Filiberto stopped by and announced that he is running unopposed in the upcoming election, and that he will be serving on the Board of the Economic Development Commission (EDC). He listened to and addressed some concerns from our members in Palm Bay. FRWA has been busy promoting and volunteering for the Republican candidates who are up for election in August and November, as well as helping with voter registration drives. To stop him, a witness named Joe Chenelly quickly tackled David Jakubonis, who was arrested and charged with second degree attempted assault. Meanwhile, it was reported that New York Democrat Governor Kathy Hochul, whom Zeldin will face in the November election, sent out a press release urging her supporters to attend one of his campaign events, claiming he would be spreading "dangerous lies, misinformation, and his far-right agenda." SECOND AMENDMENT ASSAULT. The House of Representatives – aided by two RINOs – voted to ban what they call "assault weapons" in the United States and sent the measure to the White House just prior to the August recess break. So-called Republican Pennsylvania Congressman Brian Fitzpatrick and New York Congressman Chris Jacobs helped make the final vote 217-213. Instead of vote tying, they "tied one on." With more than 24 million potentially banned firearms in common use, these draconian restrictions fill in blatant opposition to the Supreme Court's rulings in Bruen, Caetano v. Massachusetts and DC v. Heller. Their refusal to recognize this reality places everyone at risk."

**ESG MOVEMENTS**. As a proposal for the 2023 Florida Legislative Session, Governor Ron DeSantis announced an initiative to protect state residents from environmental, social, and corporate (ESG) movements that threaten the American economic system. "The leveraging of corporate power to impose an ideological agenda on society represents an alarming trend," he said. "From Wall Street banks to massive asset managers and big tech companies, we have seen the corporate elite use their economic power to impose policies on the country that they could not achieve at the ballot box." DeSantis added, "We are protecting Floridians from woke capital and asserting the authority of our constitutional system over ideological corporate power." His proposed legislation would: 1) Prohibit big banks, credit card companies and money transmitters from discriminating against customers for their religious, political, or social beliefs; 2) Prohibit State Board of Administration (SBA) fund managers from considering ESG factors when investing the state's money; and 3) Require SBA fund managers to only consider maximizing the return on investment on behalf of Florida's retirees.

**REMEMBERING ALLAN TRUCANO.** A Memorial Mass was held at St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Viera – where he also was a member of the chorale – on August 23 for **Allan Trucano**, the founder – more than ten years ago –

and first president of the Heritage Isle Republican Club. Trucano passed away on July 31 at age 80 at the St. Francis Reflections Lifestage Care Center in Melbourne, after a lengthy illness including Alzheimers and Parkinson. Active in politics for many years, he also formerly served as a Brevard Republican Executive Committee Precinct Committeeman, and spent



many hours watching political issues on TV, including former President Donald Trump's rallies to support primary election candidates in numerous states, and to "Save America." More than 100 family members, friends, neighbors, and political associates attended the mass, which was followed by a luncheon filled with Trucano's favorite Italian dishes. He also enjoyed Tootsie Rolls, and dishes of the candy treat were on each table. Trucano was a loyal and active member of the Knights of Columbus Council 8125 in Rockledge, Florida, as well as being an enthusiastic photographer. He took not only family pictures, but he was also the "go-to guy" for requests by the church for pictures of special occasions and by friends for weddings, birthday and other events. The son of the late Natale and Emma (Bulgarelli) Trucano, he is survived by his devoted wife Linda; his two sisters, Natalie Sparrer and Mary Ham (Jerry) of California; his daughters, Suzanne Lomasney (Rich) of Illinois, Kathryn of Montana, and Deanna (Glaston) of Texas; his son Jim (Michelle) of Iowa; and his stepchildren, Lynn Park (Ben) and Scott Archer (Kelley) of California. He also is survived by nine grandchildren, two step-grandsons, four great-grandchildren, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins. Trucano graduated from Iowa State University in 1965 and retired as a communications engineer with ABB Power T&D, working in Lake Mary, Florida, in 2008 – the same year he and Linda moved to Heritage Isle in Viera. He will be missed.

#### CAR BUYING SCAMS. 18<sup>TH</sup>Judicial Circuit State



Attorney Phil Archer, in his August Monthly Brief, reports on car buying scams, writing that "Used cars are in high demand, and scammers know it. Con artists are using online platforms like Craigslist, Facebook Marketplace, eBay, and others to list popular cars at very low prices. When a buyer contacts them, the car is located out of the area and some hardship has forced the sale.

But the seller has a transport company who will deliver it at the stated price, just pay the transporter who will hold the funds in escrow till it is delivered. Some even send links to 3rd party escrow companies that seem realistic but aren't. Once you've paid the third-party company, usually by a wire

transfer or prepaid debit card, your vehicle won't be delivered. The sale was a scam, and the con artist was in cahoots with the third-party company. Unfortunately, your money is gone for good." Archer adds that "An in-depth investigative study by Better Business Bureau (BBB) finds that thousands of

consumers have fallen victim to this scam, with losses totaling millions of dollars. Red flags include prices well below market value, avoiding speaking by phone, giving vague answers, won't confirm the vehicle location for inspection, or claims another buyer is waiting if you don't want the car right now. Always have a car inspected before buying and never wire funds. They are hard to track and no way to get your money back. For more information on vehicle shipping and escrow scams, read the BBB report, tips from Craigslist, Facebook Marketplace, and eBay. If you've been scammed, contact law enforcement first. Then follow-up with reports to the FTC, FBI, and your local BBB office."

**PETA.** There can be times that even a liberal organization can take a position which we conservatives can support. Case in point: after Anthony Fauci announced he would retire from the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases at the end of Biden's presidency, the non-conservative rights group People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals suggested that the "good doctor" leave now. Under his direction, the Institute has harmed millions of animals, including tens of thousands of monkeys in failed AIDS experiments that have not produced a marketable vaccine to prevent HIV, and dogs which have been subjected to hideous experiments.

**CPAC DALLAS.** When the American Conservative Union (ACU) held its second Conservative Political Action Conference (CPAC) of the year in Dallas, Texas, in early August, former **President Donald Trump** convincingly won the Republican presidential nomination straw poll, just as he did at the earlier conference in Orlando, Florida. Trump captured 69 percent of the ballots cast, while **Florida Governor Ron DeSantis** came in second with 24 percent. It



was the same 1-2 tandem as in Orlando. **ACU Chairman Matt Schlapp** said, "There's an unbreakable bond between President Trump and the conservative movement. He simply did the things he promised to do and for that they are grateful." Trump, in his closing remarks at the three-day conference, hit President Biden for failures on the economy, a "sick" open border agenda, and foreign policy. He

said the 2020 election was "rigged and stolen," and now our country is being systematically destroyed. Rallying activists for the November midterm elections, Trump also said, "We have to seize this opportunity to deal with the radical left socialists and fascists." Another speaker at the conference, Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban, received a "hero's welcome"



from the crowd and pleaded that they "not pull punches" in a culture war – going on globally – with liberals. In America, he said, under Joe Biden that fight has erupted over and over with the president's blatant promotion of abortion, the LGBT ideology, progressive government priorities like massive

spending and more. Orban, who has been in power since 2010, also criticized former President Barack Obama, billionaire George Soros, and "globalists." He said, "We must take back the institutions in Washington and in Brussels. We must coordinate the movement of our troops, because we face the same challenge." In an apparent reference to the 2024 U.S. presidential election, he added, "You have two years to get ready," He said that "Politics is not enough; this war is a culture war." Orban elicited a standing ovation when he read from the Hungarian constitution, declaring marriage to be only between one man and one woman, and that Americans need to trust their Judeo-Christian tradition. "Less drag queens and more Chuck Norris," he said. In response, "Walker Texas Ranger" star Norris reportedly said he would be happy to work with Orban for "that better future."



HERITAGE ISLE REPUBLICAN CLUB. Addressing the Heritage Isle Republican Club on August 4, political analyst and chiropractor **Dr. Sal Martingano** said that in 1963, when the international Communist Party made a list of 45 goals it wanted to accomplish worldwide, it never stopped its efforts, even after the Soviet Union fell. Today, he said, 29 of those goals "have been

accomplished" in the party's effort to take over the United States. Among those accomplished goals, Martingano said, are "capturing" the Democrat Party; gaining control of schools as "transmission belts" for socialism and Communist propaganda and putting the party line in textbooks; infiltrating the press; gaining control of key positions in radio, TV and motion pictures; presenting homosexuality, degeneracy and promiscuity as "normal, natural, healthy"; discrediting the Bible; calling the American Constitution "inadequate, oldfashioned, out-of-step with modern needs"; discrediting the FBI; discrediting the family as an institution; and emphasizing the need to raise children away from "the negative influence of parents." #### REPUBLICAN LIBERTY CAUCUS OF CENTRAL



EAST FLORIDA. Speaking at the August 1 meeting of the Republican Liberty Caucus of Central East Florida in Melbourne, **John Tobia**, who represents District 3 on the Brevard County Commission, said he is a fiscal conservative who often finds himself the only one on the all-Republican Commission to oppose measures under consideration. One example, he said,

was the recent vote to approve spending \$30 million of taxpayer funds to give to Driftwood Capital to help construct a new luxury resort in Cocoa Beach. This was "disappointing," Tobia said, adding that other hoteliers in the county cannot use these funds. Another upcoming vote, he said, would be to place on the November 8 ballot a renewal of the Environmentally Endangered Lands (EEL) tax to purchase more land, and he would need just one other commissioner to ioin him in defeating the measure (UPDATE: he did not get it). Citing lost tax revenue, he stressed that purchasing more land just keeps money off the tax rolls, and it will increase residents' property taxes. "We already have 117 county parks in Brevard, and do not have enough people to run them," Tobia added. He said that in one way, he really wished there were a Democrat on the County Commission in order to unite the Republican members in opposition. "Your job," he said to the RLC members, "is to hold us accountable." On another matter, Tobia said he is supporting retired Green Beret

Jeremy Brown, who is running for the Florida House District 62 seat – from the Pinellas County Jail in Clearwater, where he has been incarcerated since last September without due process because he dared to record FBI agents prior to the January 6 rally at the U.S. Capitol. The agents tried to recruit him to spy on his fellow patriots, but he declined. He was at the rally but did not



enter the Capitol building. When Brown later heard about the FBI using infiltrators, he became a whistleblower and subsequently was arrested. There has been no bail or a court date scheduled. For the November general election, Brown is the only Republican candidate challenging for a seat in a heavily Black and Democrat district.

In 2017, the Chinese government was offering to spend \$100 million to build an ornate Chinese garden at the National Arboretum in Washington DC. Complete with temples, pavilions

and a 70-foot white pagoda, the project thrilled local officials, who hoped it would attract thousands of tourists every year. But when U.S. counterintelligence officials began digging into the details, they found numerous red flags. The pagoda, they noted, would have been strategically placed on one of the highest points in Washington D.C., just two miles from the U.S. Capitol, a perfect spot for signals intelligence collection. Also alarming was that Chinese officials wanted to build the pagoda with materials shipped to the U.S. in diplomatic pouches, which U.S. Customs officials are barred from examining, sources said. Federal officials quietly killed the project before construction underway. The canceled garden is part of a frenzy of counterintelligence activity by the FBI and other federal agencies focused on what career U.S. security officials say has been a dramatic escalation of Chinese espionage on US soil over the past decade. Since at least 2017, federal officials have investigated Chinese land purchases near infrastructure, shut down a high-profile regional consulate believed by the U.S. government to be a hotbed of Chinese spies and stonewalled what they saw as clear efforts to plant listening devices near sensitive military and government facilities. Among the most alarming things the FBI uncovered

pertains to Chinese-made Huawei equipment atop cell towers near U.S. military bases in the rural Midwest. According to multiple sources familiar with the matter, the FBI determined the equipment was capable of capturing and disrupting highly restricted Defense Department communications, including those used by U.S. Strategic Command, which oversees the country's nuclear weapons. While broad concerns about Huawei equipment near U.S. military installations have been well known, the existence of this investigation and its findings have never been reported. Its origins stretch back to at least the Obama administration.... F.E. Warren Air Force Base, a strategic missile base, is located in Cheyenne, Wyoming, an area near a host of cell towers using Huawei equipment. It's unclear if the intelligence community determined whether any data was actually intercepted and sent back to Beijing from these towers. Sources familiar with the issue say that from a technical standpoint, it's incredibly difficult to prove a given package of data was stolen and sent overseas. The Chinese government strongly denies any efforts to spy on the U.S....But multiple sources familiar with the investigation say there's no question the Huawei equipment has the ability to intercept not only commercial cell traffic but also the highly restricted airwaves used by the military and disrupt critical U.S. Strategic Command communications, giving the Chinese government a potential window into America's nuclear arsenal.... Federal officials were also alarmed by what sources described as a host of espionage and influence activities in Houston, and in 2020, shut down the Chinese Consulate there."

Driftwood Capital is building the upscale Westin Cocoa Beach Resort & Spa. Driftwood plans to spend \$388 million on a project in which it will tear down its



502-room, two-story International Palms off State Road A1A, and build a 502-room, six-story Westin on the site. Driftwood officials say the Westin would be rated as a "4½-star" hotel -- more upscale than any other hotel in Brevard County....Driftwood Capital has asked for what amounts to up to \$1 million a year for 30 years from the county's 5% tourism bed tax to market the facility. Opponents have cried that this is corporate welfare, that we're just giving them \$30 million. The Tourism Development Council, which acts as an advisory board to the County Commission, voted 7-1 to reject the proposal....Ultimately, the decision sat solely in the hands of county commissioners, and three of the four sitting commissioners voted in favor of the grant – with District 3 Commissioner John Tobia voting plan....Ironically, the development is part of Commission District 2, which does not currently have a commissioner following Brian Lober's resignation earlier this year, citing the death of his grandmother. Florida Representative Randy Fine of Palm Bay is so opposed to the grant proposal, he withdrew his support for a potential \$900,000 in state grants for lagoon improvement projects because Brevard's 'priorities' are out- of-sync, he said – despite the \$1 million annual allotment from the tourism tax to help fund lagoon projects. Tobia now is proposing a plan to change how the tourism bed tax is divvied up. His idea: Allow all entities that collect the tax to be reimbursed up to half of what they collect for use in their own marketing campaigns. Add to the mix attorney Scott Knox, who now represents Driftwood Capital, violating the county lobbying ethics policy that was enacted under his tenure as county attorney. The violation for not reporting his lobbying work for Driftwood was brought to light by Tobia and will likely result in nothing more than a hand slap for Knox....The three commissioners who voted for the grant agree with Driftwood that the grant is a win-win proposition and will lead to a boost in tourism. Also, the Westin's hotel tax revenue, even with the grant money, will provide more revenue for the county for overall tourism marketing, beach renourishment, tourism-related capital projects, the Brevard Zoo, and cultural and sports grants."














