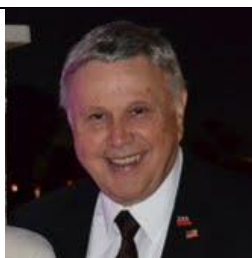

No thanks to 19 Republicans in the U.S. Senate, the Democrats passed a \$1.2 trillion infrastructure bill on August 10, and immediately followed that up with a budget resolution – for which no Republican votes were needed – to call for even \$3.5 trillion more.

The first of President Biden’s spending scams – the \$1.2 trillion bill that was forwarded to the House of Representatives for its consideration – needed 60 votes for passage, and the 50-member Senate gained 19 additional votes.

It calls for \$550 billion in new spending over the next five years on railways and public transit, rebuilding the electric power grid, and expanding broadband internet access, but the balance of the measure involves massive spending the Democrats added through the budget reconciliation process.

Conservative patriots will want to remember the names of the “helpful 19” when, and if, they seek re-election. “Back in their home states,” said **Townhall.com Managing Editor Spencer Brown**, “the people who elected them expecting to have a Republican voice represent them now need to understand that their ‘leaders’ advanced gender identity madness, institutionalized the Left’s equity agenda, and gave new life to Green New Deal policies.”

Talk show host and author **Mark Levin** pointed out that the infrastructure measure is 2,700 pages in length, and he questioned how anyone could read it all in just a matter of days. 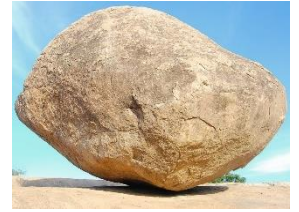

--Antony Macros-Wood, the archdeacon of Dorset in England, for ordering Reverend Charlie Boyle out of All Saints Brankscome Church as well as the home he shares with his wife and four young children, due to a complaint that he conducted Easter Sunday service without wearing a coronavirus mask. Macros-Wood also sent him a letter threatening a Clergy Discipline Measure case. Boyle, who has an exemption from mask requirements due to asthma, is being supported by the Christian Legal Center in his fight to keep his job.

--The Simpson County, Mississippi, School District, for ordering 9-year-old Lydia Booth to not wear her "Jesus Loves Me" mask to school, because it was "against school policy to have religious symbols on her mask." When her mother, Jennifer Booth, read in the school handbook that only "drug culture, profanity and obscenities" were forbidden, she asked the school district leaders for an explanation, and then learned that the policy was "modified less than an hour before it was emailed to her" and it included language barring students from wearing masks expressing religious views. So Booth has now been joined by the Christian legal organization Alliance Defending Freedom in filing a lawsuit against the school district.

--A Democrat County Board of Supervisors in California, for voting to spend \$60 million of taxpayer funds to buy 3,000 "greener" trash cans to replace the ones that line the streets of San Francisco – that's \$20,000 for each can.

--The Reverend Al Sharpton, for ranting on television the leftist lie that conservatives don't understand Critical Race Theory, and he attacked parents who object at school board meetings to the political propaganda being forced on their children, saying left-wing viewers should "show up to those same meetings, demanding that our children get a full and accurate history curriculum." The reality, of course, is that teaching students that America is inherently racist is historically inaccurate.

--The Metropolitan King County Council in Washington State, for appointing as director of its new Office of Law Enforcement

## THIS AND THAT

**ATTACKS ON THE U.S. CAPITOL.** While the blubbering representatives were holding their hearing about the January 6 insurrection at the U.S. Capitol – that did not involve any weapons – and falsely claiming that it was the "worst attack on the Capitol since the War of 1812," the conservative web site "For The Right News" listed several incidents to refute that claim. It reported: 1) In the 1850s, there were more than 70 violent altercations on the floor of Congress when Republicans and Abolitionists suggested that perhaps Democrats should not keep black people as slaves; 2) In 1915, a Harvard professor and German immigrant named Erich Muentner, who was enraged by the U.S. government sending financial assistance to Great Britain in the run-up to World War I, planted a package of dynamite in the Senate Reception room that detonated overnight causing damage; 3) On March 1, 1954, four Puerto Rican communists walked into the U.S. Capitol, unfurled a Puerto Rican flag, and then pulled out their guns, shooting and wounding five members of Congress; In 1971, members of the Weather Underground bombed the Capitol, causing \$300,000 in damage; and in 1983, a group calling itself the Armed Resistance Unit bombed the Senate wing of the Capitol, causing \$250,000 in damage. So, January 6 "worst since War of 1812"?

**BASEBALL TEAM NAMES.** So now Indians are racist, and Cleveland's Bob Feller must be turning over in his grave. Now, let's check the names of the other MLB teams. Outrageously, the largest public school teachers' union in America – the National Education Association – is suing Rhode Island mom Nicole Solas

for asking what her kindergarten daughter would be taught in school, and if lessons would include Critical Race Theory and/or gender theory material. The Arizona-based Goldwater Institute is representing Solas, saying, "This brazen and unprecedented act of intimidation by the NEA will not stand." Jon Riches, Goldwater's Director of National Litigation, said Solas "is entitled to know what her daughter's school is teaching in the classroom. She's entitled to ask questions. And she does not deserve to face legal action just for asking questions any concerned parent would ask." In April, Solas emailed the principal of her school in the South Kingstown School District asking for the kindergarten curriculum. She immediately faced stonewalling from the school, and even a threat of legal action for asking too many questions. Ultimately, she received a bill for \$74,000 to fulfill a public records request filed by the Goldwater Institute on her behalf in July. "This lawsuit won't deter me from asking questions, and I encourage all parents to do the same, so that they are empowered to make informed decisions regarding their children's education," she said.

## LOUDON COUNTY, VIRGINIA, SCHOOL BOARD.

Following several boisterous meetings with angry parents complaining about what their children are being taught in Loudon County, Virginia, the School Board held its August 9 meeting with a nearly empty room. But that did not mean an end to the fireworks. Laura Morris, a fifth-grade teacher at Lucketts Elementary School in Leesburg, railed to the board members against such controversial policies as Critical Race Theory and transgender locker rooms. I encourage all parents and staff in this country to flood the private schools." Morris added, "You've made your point. You no longer value me or many other teachers you've employed in this county. So, since my contract outlines the power that you have over my employment in Loudon County public schools, I thought it necessary to resign in front of you."

**District 53 Representative Randy Fine** told the Space Coast Chapter of ACT! Author and activist **Cathi Chamberlain** met with the Republican Liberty Caucus of Central East Florida on August 2, explaining how her book “Rules for

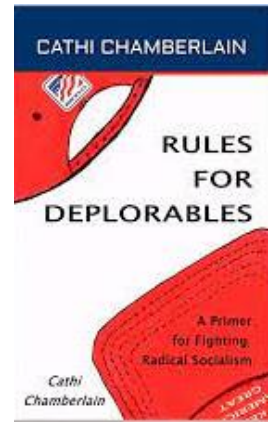

If they succeed, Chamberlain said, “We risk losing our sovereignty and freedoms for generations.” The Left today, she added, is conditioning Americans to believe “we Conservatives are the enemy,” and “to them, this is war, and we cannot let that happen – we can’t do nothing.” Chamberlain admitted that she, herself, grew up as a liberal, but it took two men to change her point of view – first **Ross Perot**, and then **Donald Trump**. **FLORIDA CONGRESSMAN MATT GAETZ.** Facing an enthusiastic rally audience of about 100 Brevard County Trump supporters in Indialantic on July 31, **Florida 1st District Republican Congressman Matt Gaetz** made the first stop on his “Florida Man Freedom Tour,” praising the 45<sup>th</sup> President and expressing opposition to coronavirus lockdowns, vaccine

passports, mask mandates, Biden administration immigration policies, the critical race theory, and election fraud. “It is an honor to serve you,” Gaetz began in his 45-minute talk. There were cheers and applause when he said “this is Donald Trump’s Republican Party,” and added that the 45<sup>th</sup> President “won the 2020 election.” The “big lie” about government lockdowns, he said, “is not that they are about Covid, they are about power.” If the Biden administration really cared about Covid, they would shut down the Southern border and keep out all of the infected illegal immigrants that are entering our country, Gaetz said. “Bill Gates. Vaccines. Put those words together and conspiracy theories abound. The tales range from stories of embedding microchips in people to the potential use of vaccines for population control. And Gates’ name is often tied to such ideas. But at least one documented idea supported by Gates is just as scary – especially in the era of COVID-19. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation has provided funding for a project that aims to record a patient’s vaccination history by injecting dye under the skin. In announcing the process via a Massachusetts Institute of



Technology news release in December 2019, its inventors suggested the injection method was mainly to aid developing countries where traditional medical records are rare or do not exist. But the dye takes on a new meaning in the wake of serious talk in the U.S. and elsewhere of vaccine passports and even the possibility of mandatory COVID vaccines. Invisible to the human eye, the dye uses nanocrystals known as quantum dots. The dots radiate slightly sub-infrared light that a certain type of smartphone can read. Measuring about 4 nanometers in diameter, the dots are held in tiny biocompatible spheres. The dye is not injected by a hypodermic syringe. Rather, it uses a patch, with microneedles – 1.5 millimeters in length – dissolving as they deliver the dye into the skin. Research is underway to use the same method to inject the vaccines themselves. The goal, according to the MIT news release, is for the dye to be ‘delivered under the skin at the same time as the vaccine.’ Tests on cadaver skin show the dye can emit light for up to five years, MIT researchers said. The dye method could be especially beneficial in tracking vaccines requiring multiple doses, according to the MIT release. ‘In order to be protected against most pathogens, one needs multiple vaccinations,’ MIT research scientist Ana Jaklenec said. ‘In some areas in the developing world, it can be very challenging to do this, as there is a lack of data about who has been vaccinated and whether they need additional shots or not’.... How will vaccination records – or lack thereof – or any other items on the nanocrystals be judged by parties other than the individual and the individual’s doctor? As we’ve learned or should have learned from the entire COVID pandemic, there are issues of competing interests. There are often considerations other than those relating to public health and disease control – considerations related to economics, psychological welfare, education, social institutions and more. The thought of injecting biological records into one’s body needs to be balanced with an alternate thought. That thought should begin with five words: What could possibly go wrong?”

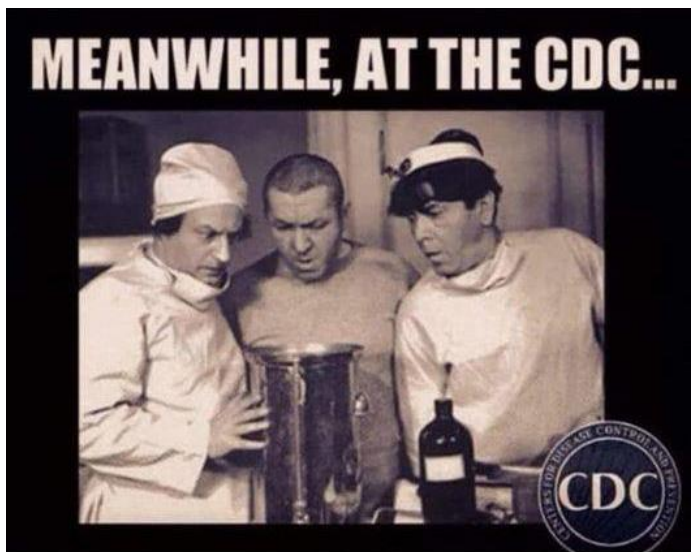

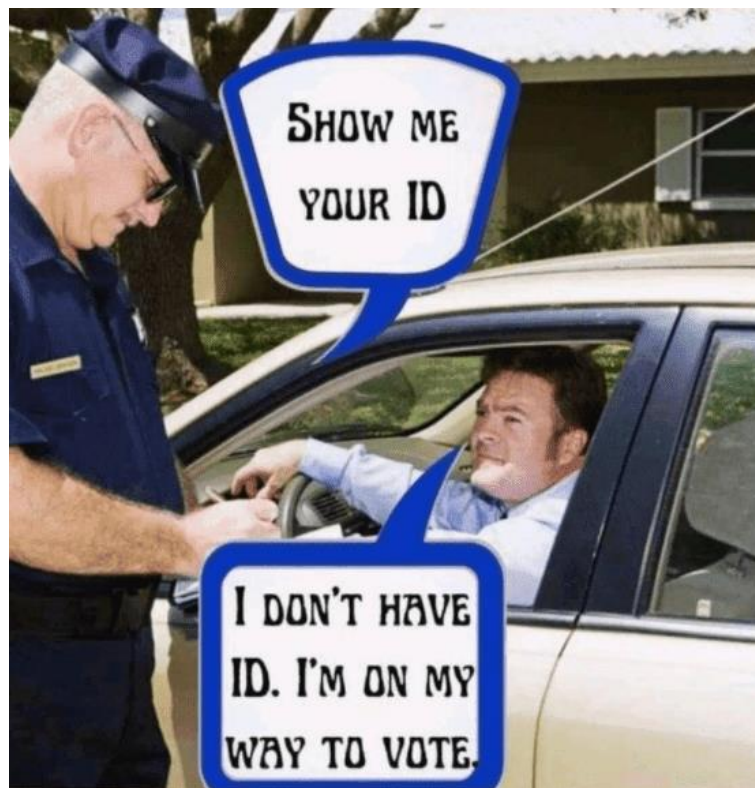
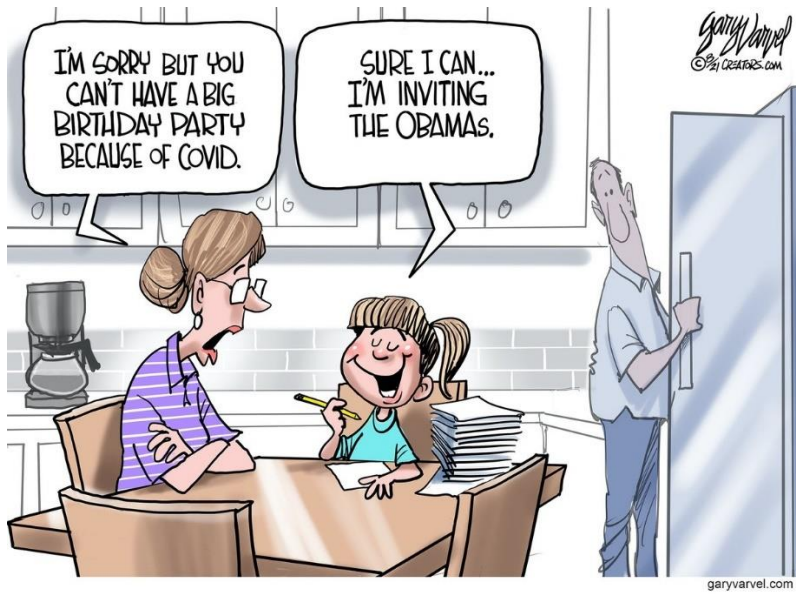
