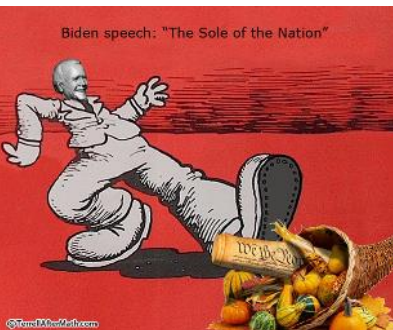
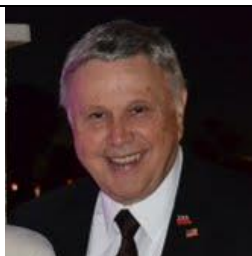
### LARA TRUMP, LAUREN BOEBERT ADDRESS SEPARATE BREVARD EVENTS

Addressing separate jam-packed Republican fund-raising dinners in Brevard County, Florida, former **President Donald Trump's** daughter-in-law, **Lara Trump**, was the keynote speaker at the Republican Liberty Caucus of Central East Florida's annual Constitution Day Dinner on September 17, while the previous week, on September 7, **Colorado Congresswoman Lauren Boebert** spoke at the Brevard Republican Executive Committee's annual Lincoln Reagan Dinner.

Both events took place at the Radisson at the Port Resort on Cape Canaveral, and both speakers received standing ovations from their respective audiences.

Lara Trump had an interesting story to tell about her transition from a single, North Carolina-born culinary student in New York to playing a key role in the 2016 presidential campaign, and it all had to do with visiting a night club in the Big Apple. Standing 5'11" plus wearing high heels, she said she noticed a man there who was even taller and looked like a "possibility." It turned out to be Trump's son, Eric, and they soon became a couple.

Even though she had no prior political experience, she said Donald Trump asked her to run his election campaign in North Carolina. Realizing the importance of women voters, she said she took a bus load of women around the Tar Heel state campaigning, and it was effective. Even though originally there were 17 Republican presidential candidates in the race, she said, "2016 was the most exciting campaign in history. We had the crowd behind us."

During the 2020 re-election campaign – in which she served as Senior Advisor – she said, "We then discussed all of his accomplishments during the first term –securing the border, Middle East peace, the strong economy, lower taxes, trade agreements, building up the military, and the like."

But now with the Democrats in power, she added, "We see disaster on the path to Socialism. The only way we can go forward is to take back the House and the Senate."

Today, Lara Trump is a Fox News contributor on several shows and hosts a weekly podcast called "The Right View." Applauded by the audience for saying she is now "a proud Florida resident," she said she was proud that her young son was able to recite the Pledge of Allegiance because he learned it in school in the Sunshine State. And speaking of Florida, she said that **Governor Ron DeSantis** is "the best Governor in the Country." She said his decision to send a busload of illegal aliens to Martha's Vineyard "was genius."

In her closing remarks, after stressing that "We need to bring back the MAGA Agenda," Trump referred to a phrase attributed to the humorous political tandem of **Diamond and Silk**, that "RED" stands for "Remove Every Democrat."



Also on the RLC program, businessman **Dragos Sprinceana**, the dinner sponsor, spoke of being born in Romania, where life was "ugly" under Communism, but being able to legally emigrate to the United States, where he founded, and now successfully operates, the transportation company GoldCoast Logistics, which has more than 650 trucks; 1,000 employees; and terminals in

Florida, Illinois and Arizona. The company also has call centers in Europe and South America.

Sprinceana said he is "blessed to live in the best country on the planet – the United States of America," which offered him "Freedom and Equal Opportunity for all." Remembering what life was like in Romania, he said we have to "make sure we are doing everything in our power to stop radical liberals from implementing Socialism and destroying the foundation of this country."

Explaining that "we need to protect at all costs the U.S. Constitution, the Supreme Law that governs all of us," he said,



“That’s why we need to re-elect President Donald J. Trump, and I am disgusted and appalled by the fact that some of us embrace a candidate like Joe Biden, who supports radical Socialists. What is wrong with these people?”



**Republican Liberty Caucus Chairman Bob White**, who served as master of ceremonies for the evening, noted that this year’s dinner – the 14<sup>th</sup> annual honoring of our Constitution, our Founders, our Veterans, and our First Responders – actually occurs on September 17 – the day in 1787 that the delegates to the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia finalized and signed the Constitution they had written. “In effect for 233 years, it is regarded as the oldest written and codified national constitution in force in the world,” White added.

He presented the Chairman’s Leadership Award to **Mike Wilson**, Chair of the Space Coast Patriots. The award consists of a plaque, which he will keep, and an oil painting of a colonial sailing vessel to be retained for one year, and then be presented for another year to the 2023 recipient.



Next on the program was the award of the Jefferson Cup, a replica of the ornate drinking vessel used by President Thomas Jefferson, given for dedication to the Jeffersonian principles of limited government, lower taxes, free and fair markets, and personal freedoms and responsibilities.

**RLC- CEF Vice Chair Rocket Weiler** presented the cup for **Tina Descovich**, former Brevard School Board member and co-founder of the nation-wide organization Moms For Liberty. Descovich was out-of-town and unable to attend in person but said in a video presentation that she was honored to receive it.



**Brevard County Sheriff Wayne Ivey** closed the dinner as auctioneer for attendees to bid on such items as a painting, a pistol, and a yacht trip.



In her keynote address at the September 7 Lincoln Reagan Dinner, Boebert – who was born in Florida but moved with her family to Colorado when she was 12 – spoke of the Founding Fathers’ “great example of faith, and who celebrated their freedom even before the battle for Independence began.” She added that returning to the Sunshine State to

attend this event, “you can feel freedom when you land in Florida.”

Now 35, married to her husband, Jayson, and the mother of four sons, Boebert is serving her first term in Congress – “an experience” – and she said, “Our government deserves a Congress that does not have Nancy Pelosi as speaker.” A strong gun rights supporter, she also revealed that she owns a restaurant in Colorado “where waitresses have open carry.” Her first job as a teenager, she said, was as an assistant manager at a McDonalds restaurant.

“I do a better job of taking care of myself than the government could,” Boebert said. “Democrat policies are destroying our country; our federal government is out of control, and the just-passed Inflation Reduction Act is just another con game.” Referring to President Biden’s call to add 87,000 new IRS agents to the government payroll, she said, “I would rather see 87,000 new Border Patrol Agents.”

Noting that she is a Trump supporter as well as a proud member of the House Freedom Caucus, she added, “You are blessed” that Florida Eighth District Congressman Bill Posey is a member as well.

Boebert received applause from the audience when she said, “I am a professional RINO hunter,” criticizing the fact that too many Republicans are willing to go along with the Democrats’ policies.

She concluded her remarks by saying, “I do have hope. I love the country and its people. If I didn’t believe we wouldn’t turn things around, I would go home, but we are here on the right path. We will come back stronger than ever taking our country back.”

Following Boebert’s address, conservative political consultant and lobbyist **Roger Stone** was a late addition to the program, stressing that he has been Trump’s close friend for 42 years.



He explained that he had been arrested for crime that never happened – lying to Congress, and that when the FBI – accompanied by a photographer from CNN – came to his Ft. Lauderdale home at the cost to taxpayers of millions of dollars, they spent nine hours going through “every nook and cranny” in the home.

Stone said he was not allowed to defend himself, and on January 25, 2019, he was arrested in connection with Robert Mueller’s Special Counsel investigation, and charged in an indictment with witness tampering, obstructing an official proceeding, and five counts of making false statements.

In November 2019, a jury convicted Stone on all seven felony counts, and was sentenced to 40 months in prison. But on July 10, 2020, days before he was scheduled to report to prison, Trump commuted his sentence. On August 17, 2020, Stone

dropped the appeal of his convictions, and the President fully pardoned him on December 23, 2020,

Stone stressed to the dinner audience that “there was a time when both parties were patriotic, but that Democrat Party no longer exists.” The fight, he said, “now is between good and evil.”

The “biggest problem today,” he said, is that “mass communications are censored. We need real Republicans, and in 2024, we must elect a president who will put America first.” Explaining that we “should not take the election for granted,” Stone said, “It will be tough, close and hard fought.”

Closing his remarks, Stone said, “We must re-elect Ron DeSantis as Florida Governor this year. There will be no Red Wave unless we recognize how tough the election will be.” He also received a standing ovation from the audience.

**Brevard Republican Executive Committee Chairman Rick Lacey**, who organized the Lincoln Reagan Dinner, presented four awards at the event. Plaques were presented to: **Florida Eighth District Congressman Bill Posey** as the Legislator of the Year. Since Congress was in session in Washington, it was accepted on his behalf by a member of his staff.

The Space Coast Association of Realtors as the Business of the Year.



**Brevard State Committeewoman Kim Adkinson** as Republican of the Year.

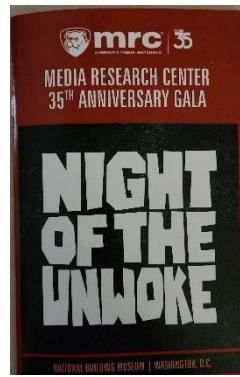


## MEDIA RESEARCH CENTER 35<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY GALA

Hundreds of supporters of the Media Research Center – the nation’s premier organization devoted to refuting America’s liberal and biased media – traveled to Washington, DC, from throughout the nation on celebrate at MRC’s 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala in a dinner program that **President and Founder Brent Bozell** humorously named “Night of the Unwoke.”



The black-tie event was an opportunity to poke fun at the unhumorous politically correct and mock the worst examples of wokeism in politics and culture, and the evening was filled



with a number of conservative celebrities making brief remarks.

Nationally syndicated radio host **Chris Plante**, served as master of ceremonies, and a lifetime achievement award was presented by **WMAL radio host Larry O’Connor** to syndicated columnist **Cal Thomas**, a suit-wearer who thanked MRC for the much-appreciated honor, and added, “I would have worn a tuxedo, but President Biden refused my student loan.”

It was President Thomas Jefferson who said, “The government you elect is the government you deserve.”

We have Washington, DC Mayor Muriel Elizabeth Bowser; New York City Mayor Eric Adams; Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti; Chicago Mayor Lori E. Lightfoot; San Francisco’s Mayor London Nicole Breed; New York Governor Kathy Hochul, who replaced Andrew Cuomo; California Governor Gavin Newsom; and Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker.

Then there are San Francisco Attorney General David Chiru; Los Angeles AG George Gascon; Manhattan DA Alvin Bragg; Chicago AG Kwame Raoul; and Atlanta’s Fani Willis, who is conducting one of three investigations against Donald Trump rather than deal with crime in his city.

Anti-Semitism is on the rise; anti-oriental crimes are on the rise; hate crimes are on the rise.

When speaking about the rampant crime crises we’re facing I could almost stop here. But when we see a shooting in Atlanta over mayonnaise on a Subway sandwich; the death of a McDonald’s worker in New York over cold French fries; the brutal beating of a 70 year old Asian women in Los Angeles for “kicks”; New York gubernatorial candidate Lee Zeldin attacked and his assailant back on the street within hours -- we need to recognize the problem in order to deal with it.

The above list is of elected officials apparently aligned with United States Attorney General Merrick Garland. As reported by Fox News and other media outlets, Garland called the uptick in violent crime in cities across the country a "matter

### RENDEZVOUS WITH REPUBLICAN WOMEN By BFRW President Jill Gentis

The Brevard Federated Republican Women’s monthly meeting September 7 featured a presentation by **Don Pearsall**, founder of Connections to a New Life and Certified Professional Life Coach. He recounted his personal experiences as a helicopter Crew Chief and door gunner in Vietnam and shared his own path to recovery from post-traumatic syndrome in his book “Back from the Front.”

Pearsall has a unique sensitivity to the psyche of homeless veterans who are still recovering and empowers them to take charge of their lives.



He also talked about the Brevard County Veterans’ Memorial Center Museum located on Merritt Island. The Museum, the third largest military memorial in the nation, has collected thousands of unique and representative artifacts from the Revolutionary War through the Ongoing War on Terror, including an artifact from the U.S.S. Arizona (sunk by the Imperial Japanese Navy in Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941) and an artifact from the Twin Towers (destroyed by Islamic terrorists on September 11, 2001). The goal of the Memorial Center and Museum is to educate the community and inspire present and future generations with the military’s service and sacrifice.

All present paused to remember and to “never forget” those who lost their lives as a result of the 9/11/2001 terrorist attacks on the Twin Towers, the Pentagon, and in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. The remembrance featured “The Names”, a commemorative poem written by Billy Collins, national poet laureate, and read before a special joint session of Congress in New York City on the first anniversary.

The meeting concluded with a presentation by a representative of Nana’s House Children’s Home, located in a gated community in West Melbourne. Nana’s House is a



non-profit organization whose funding depends on contributions. Its mission is to provide housing and support for foster families who care for the neglected, abused, needy, and abandoned children.

## FRWA IS "A CLUB OF ACTION"

At the September 2 meeting of the Federated Republican Women in Action (FRWA) in Palm Bay, the speaker, **Joe Katz**, RPOF Regional Field Director for Brevard and five other counties, stated his main job is to "organize voter contact," which involves the recruitment and training of volunteers to make contact with voters by door knocking, phone calling, etc.

Katz said he will be working to get all Republican candidates elected in November "from the bottom up," including School Boards, City Councils, and all the way up to the Governor. He started his career in politics in 2018, when he landed an Internship through the Congressional Leadership Fund and began interning for U.S. Representative Brian Mast's campaign. He then interned for U.S. Representative Ted Budd's campaign in Washington D.C.

In 2020, Katz became a Field Director for the Brian Mast campaign, and a Field Organizer for President Donald Trump's campaign. After the 2020 election, he was sent to Clayton County, Georgia, to help with the Senate run-off election, and worked as a poll watcher. He described the questionable activities he witnessed, such as the Supervisor of Elections site leaving and then coming back with a box of ballots. When asked about these events, the supervisor would not answer questions. Katz was disturbed by the lack of transparency and incompetence he witnessed. He stressed the need for transparency in elections so all voters can feel confident that our election process is fair.

Katz shared the statistics showing that someone is 6 percent more likely to vote for your candidate if a contact is made with that voter. There is also a 15 percent higher voter turnout in areas where voter contacts are made. **FLORIDA SENATOR MARCO RUBIO.** A hot dog and apple pie meet and greet was held at the Melbourne Auditorium on September 17 for **Florida Republican Senator Marco Rubio**, who is being challenged by Democrat Congresswoman Val Demings, the former chief of the Orlando Police Department. During his remarks, Rubio touted the support of 55 of the state's

sheriffs, as well as the Florida Police Chiefs Association, the Fraternal Order of Police and the Florida Police Benevolent Association. He said the record shows that Demings supported legislation defunding the police and voted 100 percent with Speaker Nancy Pelosi. He quipped that even Pelosi did not vote for herself 100 percent of the time. Currently leading in the polls just outside of the margin of error – 48-44 percent – Rubio urged the meet and greet attendees to show up at the polls and vote Republican.

**FLORIDA ATTORNEY GENERAL ASHLEY MOODY.** In her bid to win re-election in November, Florida Attorney General Ashley Moody has been endorsed by 64 out of 66 of the state's elected sheriffs. Calling them "pillars of our law enforcement community," Moody said, "We owe a debt of gratitude to these





selfless and dedicated leaders who risk their lives each day to protect and defend our state and our nation. Now is the time to defend, not defund, the police, and I am proud to always have their back as together we work to combat human and drug trafficking, opioid addiction, senior scams, and more.”



**BREVARD SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS.** Denying that the Governor or illness were involved, **Brevard County, Florida, Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott** suddenly announced her resignation – after the state’s primaries were conducted, but before the November general election. It was then up to **Governor Ron DeSantis** to appoint a replacement to finish the term of office in 2024. Scott recommended **Tim Bobanic**, her long-time Information Technology Director, for the position, and DeSantis agreed. The position will again be on the ballot in 2024. Bobanic, who will assume the Supervisor duties October 1, said, “I look forward to continuing the legacy left by Lori Scott in conducting accurate, secure and transparent elections in Brevard County.”



In Florida’s August 23 Primary Election, there were non-partisan races for County School Board positions, and **The Leadership Institute’s President Morton Blackwell** reported that among the victors in those races were more than 21 solid conservative winning

candidates – ten of whom were trained in L.I.’s new School Board Campaign Training Program. “Those new school board members will positively impact thousands of children across Florida,” Blackwell said.” They’ll use their influence to wrestle control of education away from the radical left teachers unions and restore control to parents, where it belongs.” The project helps free thousands of schoolchildren in Florida from the leftist control of their education. One of the victors, he said, is **Bridget Ziegler** in Sarasota, whom he hired earlier to be the Director of School Board Trainings at LI. She also was an incumbent candidate, and three other conservatives swept the vote for the Sarasota school district to flip control of that school board to a 4-1 conservative majority. And in her new role, she will use her firsthand experience to train other conservatives across the country to win in their districts.



**IT’S AN “OOPS” FROM THE U.S. CENSUS BUREAU.** During the 2020 population count by the U.S. Census Bureau, it now admits it “mistakenly” undercounted the population in five red states, and overcounted it in seven blue ones. The red

undercounts were in Arkansas, Florida, Mississippi, Tennessee, and Texas – joined as well by Illinois; and the blue overcounts were in Delaware, Hawaii, Massachusetts, Minnesota, New York, Ohio, and Rhode Island, joined by Utah. Some of the consequences of these “mistakes” were that based on total population, Florida and Texas should have received additional seats in the U.S. Congress, while Minnesota and Rhode Island should have lost one. And since a lot of federal funding is tied to population, this also means hundreds of millions of dollars will be sent to overcounted states at the expense of the undercounted ones. Unfortunately, there is NO remedy for these errors; the numbers are final, and the next census will not be until 2030.

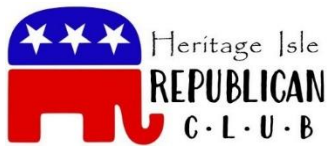


To serve as a guide for assessing education freedom in each state, the Heritage Foundation has published the first edition of what will be an annual Education Freedom Report Card for each state and the District of Columbia. The report card measures four broad categories: School Choice, Transparency, Regulatory Freedom, and Spending – using more than two dozen factors. In the inaugural 2022 edition, Florida is the top-ranked state across the board, and Arizona is in second place, with Idaho coming in third. At the other end of the spectrum, New Jersey, New York, and the District of Columbia came in 49<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, and 51<sup>st</sup> respectively – doing little to provide families with transparency, accountability, and choice...In other action, Heritage has issued a pamphlet titled “The Five Lies of CRT,” which refutes that 1) “CRT is not taught in schools.” 2) “CRT is just a way to give previously marginalized people the attention they have lacked.” 3) “CRT is not Marxist.” 4) “Those opposed to CRT just don’t want history taught.” And 5) “The use of CRT is a cynical ploy by Republicans.” Heritage says the pamphlet will help educate Americans across the country on Critical Race Theory and other issues like Socialism. Other actions, it said, will allow its more than 100 policy experts and researchers to testify before Congress dozens of times throughout the year to provide principled policy solutions to our nation’s problems, and ensure that Heritage experts appear daily in America’s top news outlets and other media to rally your fellow citizens.

**THE CURIOUS CASE OF THE DOMINION VOTING MACHINE.** First, a Dominion Voting Machine that was used in the controversial 2020 election in Michigan went missing. State officials do not know how it got there, but nearly two years later, a Goodwill Industries Thrift Store in Cadillac, Michigan, put the voting machine in an online auction, in which an Ohio Uber driver successfully bid \$7.99 for it. Making more than a quick buck on the machine, the man then listed it on E-Bay, with the following note: “Own a piece of history! This voting machine was one of thousands used in the 2020 United States presidential election and included in one of the many lawsuits against Dominion that were thrown out.” He then sold the machine for \$1,200 to Connecticut resident Harri Hursti, one of America’s foremost election machine security experts. Hursti then notified the Michigan Secretary

of State's Office and was instructed not to open the box the machine came in, but preserve it for law enforcement, who may need to wipe it for fingerprints. Next came an email saying, "Thank you again for bringing this to our attention. We have determined this device originated in one of our jurisdictions. The jurisdiction has now reported the device to law enforcement as stolen." But Michigan's Democrat Secretary of State, Jocelyn Benson, who oversees elections held in the state and notably refused to investigate allegations of voter fraud from whistleblowers in the 2020 election, responded to the news by claiming that the missing Dominion voting machine being sold online "does not necessarily mean that there has been a lapse in voting security." She added, "Michigan's elections are secure. Before every election, we test every machine for accuracy. We've never seen, even with this unauthorized access to machines, any actual evidence of any challenges or wrongdoing or lack of security in the process. While our elections remain secure and safe, we take seriously all violations of election law and will be working with relevant authorities to ensure there are consequences for those who break the law." Hursti's further comment was that "election officials in Michigan were not even aware that they had been missing a voting machine. It is shocking that only when we started asking, 'Does it belong somewhere?' Only after that, did they realize it had been stolen."

**ANTI-COVID VACCINES.** It took questioning by the Romanian member of the European Parliament, Cristian Terhes, to get officials from Moderna and AstraZeneca to expose some serious secrets about the safety and efficacy of anti-COVID vaccines – secrets the manufacturers would rather have kept hidden from the public. Moderna CEO Stephane Bancel admitted that because the vaccines were produced quickly at the request of governments, they were granted certain liability protections, which means they cannot be held accountable for any adverse reactions from the experimental jabs off of which they are making billions. AstraZeneca Executive Vice President Iskra Reic confirmed this was the case. Bancel further admitted the manufacturers knew full well that their vaccines did NOT prevent the spread of the virus, a claim which many governments made in order to force the injections on their citizens.

Since then, the Biden administration has decreed that active members of the military can take time off from their duties to obtain sex-change surgeries and all related hormones and drugs at taxpayer expense.... Much of the emphasis of wokeness today is on promoting the idea that America is fatally flawed by systemic racism and white privilege. Is California willing to build the hundreds of thousands of recharging stations a complete conversion to battery-powered cars would require? Could Californians drive their mandated ZEVs into other states without running out of juice? There are other concerns, such as the cost of EVs, the life of batteries and the high cost of replacing them, the source of lithium from countries that are poor practitioners of human rights, as well as where all the required new electricity will come from (mainly fossil fuels now, though greenies think costly and ugly windmills, wind and solar sources can produce sufficient power, which is unlikely). There is little consideration for increasing the availability of nuclear power, again because of the left's antipathy toward that clean energy source. Then there is the premise on which 'climate change' is based. It is more theoretical than scientific (remember 'global cooling?'); more political than logical. With China and India still producing the most CO2, will electric cars in America address the perceived problem? Ordering the Census Bureau to conduct another actual recount in the 14 affected states would be a complex, expensive undertaking that would provide numbers on a different date than the original census whose population totals from April 1, 2020, would still be in effect for the rest of the states, raising fundamental fairness issues given the high mobility of our population. And ordering a new census of the entire nation also seems impractical. But there is no question Congress needs to get to the bottom of what happened. It must use its oversight authority to investigate the Census Bureau, its methods, procedures and operations to determine how and why these errors happened. We have to ensure that the necessary changes are made that won't allow this to happen again.... It's probably just coincidental how those mistakes always seem to go in one direction or something. Otherwise, it might seem like a completely perfect system for Democrats."

The “Bee” also reported that New York Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez has tearfully recounted how Florida Governor Ron DeSantis yanked her from her Venezuelan home and human-trafficked her to Martha’s Vineyard, where she died, and following her martyrdom, expressed hopes that Taylor Swift would sing at her somber funeral service. It added that AOC’s body would be returned to her homeland, where it will be fed to starving Venezuelans.
