

late "National Review" founder and editor William F. Buckley. Sadly, James Buckley passed away on August 18. He was a gentleman, a thinker, and a patriot, who was dear to the conservative movement.

--You never know what "pearls of wisdom" will come next from former First Lady, former U.S. Senator, former Secretary of State, and former failed presidential candidate Hillary Rodham Clinton. This time, she actually said that we MAGA Republicans – her "basket of deplorables" – are to blame for the summer heat wave the United States has been enduring. Eight Republican presidential candidates gathered for their first debate on August 23 at the Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee, which will be the site of the 2024 GOP National Convention, but missing from the group was the polling leader – former **President Donald Trump**.

Participating in the two-hour Fox News debate — after reaching participation thresh holds required by the Republican National Committee — were Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, business entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy, former Vice President Mike Pence, former South Carolina Governor Nikki Haley, South Carolina Senator Tim Scott, former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie, former Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson, and North Dakota Governor Doug Burgum.

--The U.S. Women's Soccer Team is out of World Cup contention, having been beaten by Sweden when "star" Megan Rapinoe missed a penalty shot – and then laughed about it. Big yawn. There was no love lost between the team and soccer fans, columnist Todd Starnes said, "because the team refused to sing the national anthem. They also refused to place their hands over their hearts. Instead, most of the team just stood there, slouched over – smacking chewing gum and smirking." Not to be outdone, the satirical "Babylon Bee" joined in the fun – alleging that Donald Trump received yet one more indictment – this time for mocking the women's soccer team.

--The Public Relations Department at Texas A&M University was pleased to announce that according to a national survey, Joe Biden is the sixth highest ranking U.S. president in the nation's history. Here is its explanation: Abraham Lincoln, Ronald Reagan and Donald Trump tied for first place. Twenty-three other presidents tied for second place. Another 17 tied for third place. Jimmy Carter was alone in fourth place, and Barack Hussein Obama came in fifth. Finally, even though he has only been in office two years, Joe Biden claimed sixth place.

--Before moving to conservative Brevard County, Florida, 17 years ago, I lived for 35 years in Montgomery County, Maryland – one of, if not the – most liberal county in America. This is where my daughter and son attended school growing up, and I am grateful that they retained their conservative values. So, this month, I just shook my head about a federal appeals court dismissing a coalition of parents' lawsuits against Montgomery County Public Schools, rejecting their opposition to the schools' gender support plan, and affirming that students' gender-transitions can be kept from their parents.

--Hurricane Hilary hit California and Nevada this month, and at press time, the satirical website "The Babylon Bee" said it destroyed 30,000 e-mails, and also reported that the World Meteorological Organization did announce that any and all deaths resulting from Hilary will be ruled as "suicides."

The debate may have been staged by Fox News. According to multiple news reports, the candidates and their prep camps were given the questions in advance.

Announcing ahead of time that he would not participate in the Fox News debate conducted by Bret Baier and Martha MacCallum, Trump spent the first 45 minutes of the debate time participating in an X (formerly Twitter) discussion with former Fox News host Tucker Carlson.

DeSantis, in his debate remarks, said the 2024 election is not about the events of January 6, 2021, that led to indictments of Trump, and "we have to focus on our future, and reversing the decline of our country." On other topics, he said he did not regret signing the six-week abortion ban in Florida; he would authorize the use of lethal force to protect the U.S. southern border; much of the learning decline taking place in schools

today is related to closures during the Covid-19 pandemic; and regarding Dr. Anthony Fauci, said that rather than coddle him, "you bring Fauci, you sit him down, and you say, 'Anthony, you are fired."

Ramaswamy said he believed Trump had been "the best president of the 21st century;" called climate change "a hoax," saying that more people of dying of bad climate change policies than they are of actual climate change; saying that America is in the middle of a national identity crisis;" and that he would stop payments to Ukraine – which is not a U.S. priority – in its war with Russia.

Pence said that as vice president, he was asked by Trump to prioritize him over the Constitution, and "I chose the Constitution, and I always will;" calling Ramaswamy "a rookie," he added that "now is not the time for on-the-job training;" the country needs a leader on the abortion issue; he voted to be a "champion for life in the Oval Office;" and that he worked as vice president with Mexican leaders to control the border; and would partner with the Mexican military to hunt down and destroy the drug cartels.

Haley said she trusted the American people to pick their nominees and added that they believe "it's time for a new generational conservative leader;" in Ukraine, "a win for Russia is a win for China;" urged her competitors to be honest with the American people and acknowledge that a Republican president cannot pass a national ban without winning 60 votes in the Senate; acknowledged that climate change is "real;" called for China and India to cut emissions; and criticized Trump by pointing to rising spending during his presidency.

Scott said he supports a national abortion ban at a minimum of 14 weeks, arguing that failing to do so would allow blue states to continue providing abortions, saying "We can't leave it to Illinois. We can't leave it to Minnesota. We cannot let states like California and New York have abortions on demand up to the day of birth. It is immoral. It is unethical. It is wrong;" and asked if Vice President Pence did the right thing on January 6, answered "absolutely."

Christie, the loudest Trump critic in the group, said the former president's conduct "is beneath the office of the United States;" said Congressional spending is "robbing our country and it is wrong;" thought Trump was a "coward" for skipping the debate; and derided Ramaswamy as "an amateur."

Hutchinson, who joined Christie as being the only two in the debate who said they would not pardon Trump if he gets convicted on charges that many believe are bogus, said new leadership is needed to bring out the best in America; and he was proud to have signed pro-life legislation while in office.

Burgum, who signed a six-week abortion ban in North Dakota, was the only candidate against a federal abortion ban, saying it would violate the principles of federalism in the Constitution; he made a pitch for electing a president who understands small towns, such as those in his state; and said, "the economy, energy and national security are tied together."

Meanwhile, Trump told Carlson that it is beneath him to appear with the other candidates on the debate stage because of his large lead in the polls. He cited this frontrunner status

in the Republican race – despite facing 91 criminal charges for which he maintains his innocence – to suggest that he doesn't need to give his rivals a platform to attack him. He added that his polls allow him to stay cheerful even when he gets indicted, because it means that people get it – see that it's a fraud.

He particularly spoke critically of Hutchinson – saying the former Arkansas governor should not be running for president – and Christie – saying the former New Jersey governor runs "solely on the basis" of going after him.

Asked by Carlson about his former running mate, Trump said he was "disappointed" with Pence, and that he hasn't spoken to him "in a long time." Regarding left-leaning Democrat opponents, the former President said, "They are savage animals. They are people that are sick."



The next Republican debate, also scheduled by Fox, will be held September 27 at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library in Simi Valley, California. For now, Trump plans to skip that one as well.

I toyed with the idea of writing about our two-tiered justice system, but anyone who subscribes to the Space Coast Tusk already has seen or read the stories.

You may have missed the story of a former New Jersey State Police trooper who was sentenced to 30 months in federal prison for conspiring to defraud the IRS, falsifying his tax returns and witness tampering, the U.S. Attorney's Office announced. The judge ordered Samuel Davis pay \$71,558 in restitution to the IRS and fined him \$10,000, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office.

Or the story of a former Baltimore Police Commissioner, Darryl De Sousa, sentenced to 10 months in federal prison for three counts of failing to file individual federal tax returns. The judge also ordered De Sousa to perform 100 hours of community service and ordered him to pay restitution in the full amount of the government's loss, which is \$67,587.72.



All this while Hunter Biden owed \$1.2 billion in back taxes and receives a slap on the wrist and would have received immunity from future criminal acts.

Most, if not all, of our readers, know about the "coincidences" of charges against former President

Donald Trump being filed immediately after new developments emerged in the investigation into Hunter's business dealings. Once is chance, twice is coincidence 4 times it's no longer accidental.

The chronology:

March 17 -- Hunter Biden admits that the laptop is his.

March 18 -- Manhattan D.A, Alvin Bragg hands down an indictment.

June 8-- FBI documents are released allegedly implicating President Biden was involved in a bribery scheme with international companies, including Burisma, during his time as Vice President.



June 9 -- Jack Smith announces Trump's indictment for possession of classified documents at Mar-a-Largo.

July 26 -- Hunter Biden's plea deal is rejected by the judge, and he accidentally admits to receiving money from a Chinese company linked to the Communist Party.

July 27 -- Smith filed four new charges against Trump.

July 31 --, Devon Archer testifies, stating that the Bidens were selling the "brand" (the Biden family name) and that Joe Biden was on the phone with people involved in Hunter's businesses over 20 times.

August 1 -- Jack Smith indicted Trump for his alleged involvement with a plot to overthrow the 2020 election.

Fani Willis, the Fulton County, Georgia D.A, broke the string by indicting a former president and 19 co-defendants, were indicted on wide ranging charges including a RICO charge (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organization). She campaigned on doing just that. She is now under investigation herself by the House for coordinating with the DOJ and Special Prosecutor Jack Smith.

The timing she set for the start of the trial is one that is impossible to meet. With 19 codefendants and all the discovery motions and other motions it will never be a date set that can be met.

In the meantime, the Republican House is mulling over the possibility of an Impeachment Inquiry of President Biden. It is fraught with problems and the scenario is not an optimistic one for the future of the Republican Party.

Whoever the nominee for the Republican Party is, he or she will need the support of independents. Attempting to impeach the sitting president will do nothing to advance that possibility. In my opinion, an impeachment would look like retribution for the Trump impeachments. A move to impeach may not even get enough House Republican votes to move forward. If it fails, it would only cement support of Democrats for Biden. Independents will see it as an attempt to undermine the 2024 election. There is no possibility that the Impeachment trial would be successful in the Senate.

Rather, the Republicans need to concentrate on inflation, the border, and national security. The United States needs to regain its leadership on the world stage. We need to have strategies to battle corruption and transparency. The mainstream media has made climate and the environment a major issue. The Republicans need a policy to deal with this.

The party needs to come up with an answer to the abortion issue. We understand that the policies should be left to the states, but the Democrats have successfully planted the idea that the Supreme Court criminalized abortion. The Republicans have done nothing to explain that and present a cohesive answer to the accusation.

LGBTQ+ issues must be addressed. Whether you believe that those rights have been stretched to the limits or not, it is an issue that independents might be focused on.

Plorida Congressman Bill Posey, thanking the
Brevard Federated
Republican Women for

their support of him, liberty and our Republican Party, noted at our Luncheon Meeting on August 2 that our nation is headed in the wrong direction under the leadership of President Joe-Biden.

Posey recalled the two-and-one-half years when the U.S. Government was closed...a time when the peoples' house was closed to the public by Nancy Pelosi. He went on to say that we have never had a government that is so radical, so derelict in their duties, and so politically weaponized. For example, he said, the indictments and



fraudulent investigations against our former president are a

new low, making us look like a second world country. It seems that every time they uncover another crime of the Biden organization, they file another indictment against Donald Trump. Although the Presidential Records Act guarantees that former presidents are allowed to have their records, the Deep State and the radical media maintain that the documents recovered from our former president are confidential and therefore cannot be seen. Furthermore, these indictments rely on anonymous sources and secret whistleblowers who cannot be verified or validated.

Posey said that the Department of Justice has embraced a twotier system of justice which seeks to undermine our way of life, our institutions, and the pursuit of the American dream for anyone who doesn't hold their radical leftist, and Marxist views. They target parents, military personnel, children, women, Catholics, pro-life activists, the Second Amendment, and other Constitutional rights, and now even our cars, gas stoves, and electric light bulbs.

The Radical Left consistently attacks anyone who disagrees with them, Posey said, adding that their aim is to demoralize us, make us feel like criminals, and make us feel undeserving of our freedom. He countered emphatically with "Wanting to be a patriotic American is not a crime."

Mainstream media doesn't report the push back by the Republican House, and Posey enumerated several actions that he and his Republican colleagues are taking:

- --First, we ended the Democrats' Covid "stay at home' policy and "voting by telephone" allowed by former speaker Nancy Pelosi.
- -- Second, Republicans stopped the Biden government from selling our strategic petroleum reserves to our adversaries.
- -- Third, we challenged the ESG (Environmental, Social and Corporate Governance) rules by repealing controversial policy agendas and regulations...but Biden vetoed it.
- -- Fourth, we created a Select Committee to investigate the weaponization of government and the Deep State.
- -- Fifth, Republicans are fighting to defund the Woke agenda by passing a Woke-free National Defense Act and a Wokeless Federal Aviation Administration reauthorization.
- -- Sixth, we passed an Authorization to Secure Borders Act to protect our nation by building the wall, targeting the cartels, and stopping the influx of Fentanyl, which the other side is unwilling to support.
- -- Seventh, we introduced legislation, with the support of Florida's awesome Attorney General Ashley Moody, which allows states to enforce immigration laws if the federal government is unwilling to do that.
- --Eighth, Posey sponsored House Resolution 426 culminating in Biden's failure to protect the States from foreign invasion as is his duty under the Constitution. Posey said that many believe the President has committed other

crimes as well, but it is very clear that he has not honored his Constitutional duty to protect our borders.

- --Ninth, Republicans passed the Energy Reform policy, which focuses on reforming fuel prices and building up American energy.
- -- Tenth, Republicans are trying to stop the clear threat of China's attempt at world economic domination which they hope will lead to military superiority. Biden vetoed a bipartisan bill to stop China from violating our Trade Laws by rescinding Biden's Executive Order that waives tariffs for products made in China. Even Biden's State Department warned that China is violating and circumventing our Trade Laws by using slave labor and by shipping their products through other countries and fraudulently relabeling their products to look as if they were made in those countries. These actions permitted by Biden and his administration undermine all business in our Country. Although Posey had the support of twelve Democrats in the Senate, Biden vetoed the bill.
- --Eleventh, at the Government Committee on Hearing Censorship, Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. tried to talk about his experiences with censorship when fellow Democrat (Florida) Debbie Schultz, repeatedly shouted "Don't let him speak!". This shocked the other Democrats.
- --Twelfth. To correct this, Posey said they introduced legislation for people to be in-charge of their own information to ensure their privacy and protection under the First Amendment.
- --And lastly, Posey talked about our country's fiscal condition. He said that we are \$32.4 trillion in debt, not to mention additional unfunded future liability for Social Security, Medicare, and Military benefits. Posey's biggest fear for our country is hyperinflation. When Obama was President, his own Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff said that our debt is the biggest threat to national security more than any other country.

Posey closed with an important thought. He said we cannot let the Radical Left silence or intimidate us. We must continue to stand up and fight for change. A brilliant example of courage is U.S. District Judge Maryellen Noreika, who upon reviewing the Hunter Biden case, noticed that the plea deal gave him immunity against future criminal prosecution despite on-going criminal investigations. She refused to accept Hunter Biden's plea and forced him to plead Not Guilty. Posey asked that we pray for her discernment. He said that Judge Noreika is his candidate for Patriot of the Century because this is the first time to legally penetrate the Deep State and reveal what they have been doing for a long time.

Florida Lieutenant Governor Jeanette Nunez announced the new state budget allocates more than \$65 million for Alzheimer's and dementia care and

research, an increase of \$12.5 million over last year. "That's something we are very proud of," she said. "We put our money where our mouth is and we understand we need to be forward-thinking and making sure we're funding this in a way that's appropriate."

Florida ranks first in the country for funding for Alzheimer's and dementia. An estimated 580,000 people aged 65 and older in Florida are living with Alzheimer's disease or dementia. Approximately 827,000 Floridians are serving as family caregivers for those afflicted.

Governor Ron DeSantis announced a \$400 million early pay down of Florida debt, saving taxpayers in the state nearly \$34 million. The early debt payments are part of his Debt Reduction program, and Framework for Freedom budget. The program reduces state debt by accelerating the payoff of bonds prior to maturity, avoiding subsequent interest costs.

Since DeSantis took office, nearly \$5 billion in state debt has been paid down, while the national debt has increased by more than \$10 trillion. "While Washington has governed irresponsibly and ballooned the national debt," he said, "the Free State of Florida is providing a blueprint for fiscal responsibility. We put Floridians front and center in every decision we make and are proud to continue saving them money through smart fiscal policy."

Beginning November 2, Breeze Airways will provide service between Vero Beach and Providence, Rhode Island on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays – an additional destination to Breeze Airways existing flights between Vero Beach, Hartford, Connecticut and White Plains, New York.

Melbourne Main Street Board Member Corey Runte and Melbourne Mayor Paul Alfrey have received prestigious

awards from Florida's Secretary of State Cord Byrd during his annual recognition event of Florida's Main Street organizations.

Alfrey received one of three Local Leader of the Year awards for his dedication to downtown Melbourne, support of key economic development programs, and his leadership on public safety issues.

Runte was named Board Member of the Year in recognition of his more than 12 years of outstanding service to Melbourne Main Street. The organization also received the "Telling Your Story" Award for their rebranding campaign, which included creation of a new logo and visual identity, development of a comprehensive new website, and the production of new promotional materials and street-pole banners.

--Florida is celebrating one year of the state's Coordinated Opioid Recovery Network (CORE) helping to break the cycle of addiction. Governor Ron DeSantis said CORE is "pioneering the future of recovery in America. While Biden's Border Crisis exacerbates the deadly influx of Fentanyl and leftist states stock vending machines with drug paraphernalia, Florida refuses to sit idly by as these deadly drugs ruin and take lives."

CORE Network focuses on essential addiction treatment rather than enabling, and from 2021 to 2022, more than 300 lives were saved in Florida – the highest decrease among all states in the U.S.

Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Service Wilton Simpson and Brevard County Sheriff Wayne Ivey held a joint press conference in Titusville to stress the important role of parents and caregivers in preventing vehicular heatstroke fatalities. Florida currently leads the nation in these tragedies.

Simpson said every fuel pump across the state will have a new inspection sticker reiterating the critical message to NEVER LEAVE CHILDREN OR PETS IN A HOT VEHICLE." Ivey added, "This is an education and awareness campaign to remind parents and pet owners that...in a split second, something could go wrong."

The Melbourne Police Department's Traffic Enforcement Unit is conducting an education and enforcement campaign called "Operation Back-to-School" to reduce accidents and increase safety at school bus stops and within active school zones in the city. It will run through September 14.

Traffic officers in unmarked vehicles are being assigned to school bus stop locations that have received safety complaints, and officers on motorcycles will be deployed to active school zones to watch for safety violations, such as drivers using a mobile device while in that area.

To prevent school traffic accidents, the police department recommends that motorists come to a complete stop and check for pedestrians, bicyclists and vehicles before turning; that pedestrians always cross at marked crosswalks and look both ways; and that bicyclists always ride with the traffic, use proper hand signals, and obey all safety and road signs. A rider or passenger under age 16 must wear a bicycle helmet.

The 74th Space Coast Honor Flight (SCHF) to Washington, D.C., is scheduled to take off September 9. Its mission is to take World War II, Korean War, and Vietnam Veterans to visit their War Memorials in our nation's Capital. This is a unique opportunity to show gratitude to the heroes who made it possible for us to enjoy the freedoms we have every day.

SCHF has openings for Guardians, volunteers, new donors, and remaining seats for Veterans still interested in the Honor Flights taking place throughout the remainder of 2023.

Brevard County led the state, country, and most of the world with 50,000 sea turtle nests in 2022. According to the Sea Turtle Preservation Society, 2023 is shaping up to be a record year, with Green Sea Turtle nesting surpassing loggerheads.

After downgrading the nation's credit rating from AAA to AA+, Fitch Rating affirmed Florida's AAA credit rating, the highest rating available. Florida has maintained the highest rating category by the three major credit rating agencies for five consecutive years.

BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF WAYNE IVEY. Calling Brevard County, Florida "one of the safest places in the country to live, work, play, and raise a family." Brevard Sheriff Wayne Ivey announced he will run for a fourth term in office in 2024. "By allowing me to serve as your Brevard County Sheriff," he said in a social media video announcement to residents, "you have given me the

honor to work alongside the 1,700 amazing men and women of our agency who work hard each and every day to keep our community safe – men and women who have dedicated their lives to serving with pride, honor and professionalism." Ivey said that in the 10-plus years he has been in office, the crime rate drastically dropped by 52 percent. "That's an amazing accomplishment when you consider that our population has increased significantly," he said, "and in Brevard County we have zero tolerance for crime." The multi-pronged approach to lowering the crime rate, he said, involved developing a partnership with our citizens and actually solving crimes. He

said Brevard's approach to Community Relations and Crime Prevention "earned the honor of being named the State of Florida's Crime Prevention Unit of the Year by the state's Crime Prevention Association. Ivey also noted that his budget "is considered to be one of the most transparent and fiscally sound budgets in the state. He noted that his office also assumed law enforcement responsibilities for Port Canaveral, district school security and animal services. Thanking everyone for their "amazing support," Ivey concluded his video by stating "I would be honored if you would allow me to continue serving as your Sheriff."

ANTI-PRONOUN MOVEMENT. Leftist lawmakers in the United States are pushing to remove pronouns from the U.S. Code. According to www.republicanpost.net, as transgender activism continues to exert influence in society and within the ranks of the U.S. government, a growing number of individuals are pushing to restrict the First Amendment rights of some Americans in order to protect the feelings of others. A poll by Redfield & Wilton Strategies indicates that 44 percent of respondents between the ages of 25 and 34 think it should be a crime to use the "wrong gender pronoun" to refer to an individual. Back in the 1990s, Brevard County shared the same telephone area code with Orlando – 407. It was spacelaunch aficionado Osband who went to the Florida Public

Service Commission meeting in Orlando in September 1998 to propose a novel idea – because of the Space Coast's involvement with rocket launches, change the telephone area code to 321 - to mimic NASA's countdown sequence. The PSC officials agreed to his request, and the new area code debuted in November 1999. Titusville resident Osband even requested and received for his cell phone the number 321-543-He spent decades greeting and 8633 (321-LIFTOFF). educating thousands of Space Coast launch watchers, always wearing a green shirt because green meant "go". He also was a volunteer at the American Space Museum, Cape Canaveral Space Force Museum and Sands Space History Center. Osband passed away on August 6 at age 72. The Space Coast Office of Tourism said, "Ozzie's legacy will live on, and he will be missed."

But after a judge dismissed those charges, they filed a civil lawsuit against the city, arguing their First Amendment rights had been violated. After another judge rejected a request to dismiss the suit, it was determined that the city will have to pay them a combined \$300,000 for the incident.
- --The Oregon Health & Science University, for telling long-time patient Marlene Barbera who suffers from breast cancer and was scheduled to receive a double mastectomy procedure that she can no longer receive any treatment at any of its facilities, because she expressed "disrespectful and hurtful remarks about our LGBTQ community and staff" to her doctor regarding a transgender flag hanging in a facility's reception area.
- --Boston Red Sox General Manager Brian O'Halloran, for releasing pitcher Matt Dermody who had been called up from the minor leagues in the middle of Pride Month for a tweet he sent out in 2021, saying that "homosexuals will not inherit the kingdom of God and will go to hell. May we all examine our hearts, ask Jesus to forgive us and repent of all our sins. I love you all in Christ Jesus!" O'Halloran added, "We're proud of our history celebrating Pride Night and standing next to the LGBTQ+ community. We're sorry that a roster decision that we made caused harm to that community. We regret that it hurt people in the community, it hurt our fans, it hurt people that work in the organization." How well or not that Dermody pitched wasn't a factor.
- --The Massachusetts Department of Children and Families, for rejecting the foster parent application of Michael and Catherine Burke, for their strict adherence to the Roman Catholic faith, which follows traditional views on gender and marriage. The couple is suing state officials for its "woke

policy," which requires foster parents to agree to "affirming" treatment of a hypothetical transgender child, and the department claimed they wouldn't be "affirming" IF a child in their care turned out to be transgender.

--While President Joe Biden continues to dodge questions about his son, Hunter; foreign bribes and government cover-ups, the "New York Post Editorial Board says it

is "long past time" for him to answer tough questions. Americans are demanding answers on a series of scandalous revelations, the board said, and if the media continues to fail to ask questions, this is "journalistic malpractice."

- --En route to another vacation stop on August 21, Biden finally made a quick stop in Maui and delivered brief, bumbling remarks about comparing the devastating fires and massive deaths in Lahina to a kitchen fire in his Delaware home 19 years ago that a fire official at the time said was contained in 20 minutes. When the President did not make plans to visit Hawaii immediately after the devastation, many residents said they did not want him to come. And when asked about the massive death toll, his response was "no comment." But he did pledge long-term government support for Lahina's rebuilding effort.
- --After Health Secretary Xavier Becerra recommended that people receive six COVID-19 shots a year, and the watchdog organization Functional Government Initiative (FGI) sued the Biden administration for failing to comply with timelines laid out in the law, the administration conceded that "there is no scientific evidence" to support the recommendation. A FGI spokesman said it is "tremendously irresponsible for the government's chief health official to fire off tweets recommending the frequent injections."
- --Attending the Iowa State Fair in Des Moines, Arizonan **Kari Lake**, a potential Senate candidate, was invited to milk a cow. A large media crowd gathered to watch, and Lake took the opportunity to educate them on gender identity. "You know there's only two genders, right? There's only two genders, and they know that in Iowa," she said. "I challenge "The New York Times" reporter and "The Washington Post" reporter to try and milk a cow, and then try to milk a bull, and see how that goes," Lake added with a smile. No reporter apparently took her up on the offer.
- --Long-time Washington Commanders radio host Don Geronimo has learned the hard way that today's woke organizations have no toleration for jokes they do not find funny. Geronimo was fired from WBIG-FM and barred from the Commanders' facility because when a female sports reporter walked past him, while on the air, he called out:" Hey, look, Barbie's here. Hi, Barbie girl." WUSA sports anchor Sharla McBride responded that she felt "incredibly insulted and embarrassed," and has "never been disrespected in such a blatant manner while trying to do my job." The radio station's regional president, Aaron Hyland, said, "We take matters of

this nature very seriously, and this behavior does not align with our core values."

--Democrat Rhode Island State Senator Joshua Miller was arrested after surveillance video showed him keying a car with an anti-Biden sticker on it. Pleading "no contest" to the charge, he was ordered to pay \$2,850 in restitution to the vehicle owner, and to donate another \$250 to the Rhode Island Community Food Bank.

--Disgracefully, when the U.S. women's soccer team played (and defeated the women from Vietnam) during a match in New Zealand, only six of the eleven American players bothered to place their hands over their hearts and sing during the playing of "The Star Spangled Banner." But when Vietnam's national anthem, "Song of a Marching Army," was played, all of those team members proudly joined in. The gestures were not missed by American fans, who hammered their own soccer team for their lack of response.

--Liberals were stunned when the Hamtramck, Michigan, City Council – in a city with 28,000 residents adjacent to Detroit – voted unanimously to prohibit the display of LGBT Pride flags on all municipal properties. They assumed the council had to be a group of anti-gay Republicans, but it turns out that the entire group is Muslim – the only U.S. locale where this is the case.

--Someone in Missouri posted a photo on social media of a house decked out in Trump campaign signs and banners, and asked the question: "What would you do if this was your nextdoor neighbor?" In response, the person who runs the Twitter account for the state's Democrat Party, responded: "The roof is on fire. We don't need no water. Let it burn," but then deleted the tweet. Disturbed by that violent threat, Missouri Senator Josh Hawley wrote: "Here's the Missouri Democrat Party advocating for a Trump supporter's home to burn down. Sick. There's no place for this kind of disgusting, violent rhetoric in Missouri." And podcaster Todd Starnes said, "Folks, the level of vitriol in national politics is off the charts - and the main instigators happen to be Democrats. I'd normally tell the Democrats to do better. But I don't think they can. It turns out their party is a basket of bitter, angry deplorables."

--The Canadian organization Trillium Gift of Life Network of Ontario had the gall to contact Megan Harper to ask if she would be willing to donate the organs of her husband, Garnet Harper, while he was lying on his death bed. He died needing an urgent kidney to survive, and while there were several people ready, willing and able to donate one to him, he was denied treatment in Canada because he had not been vaccinated for Covid. "He wasn't good enough to receive organs from them," his widow said. "I can't describe the feeling. It makes me sick to my stomach. I said I'm not going to be participating in this program as long as people like my husband are not eligible to receive organs that are from the Trillium Network."

--After Anaheim, California, police found the body of 65-

year-old Sheryl Ferguson, who had been shot, in their home, they arrested her 72-year-old husband, Jeffrey Ferguson, on murder charges and booked him into an Orange County jail on \$1 million bail. Ferguson should have been familiar with the procedure, since his position in the county is as a Superior Court judge.

--Investigative journalist James O'Keefe reports that at a Best Buy store in Jacksonville, Florida, a manager explained that employees are permitted to display LGBT flags, but Christian crosses and Bibles are not "work appropriate."

--The woke Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) has greatly upset high school girls and their parents in Green Bay, by determining that a transgender boy will be allowed to play on the girls' baseball team this upcoming school year, despite numerous complaints regarding injuries and a shared locker room. The WIAA even told the students that if they have issues with the decision, they should seek counseling. During summer practices, the parents even said the girls received welts and bruises from the hard play of the transgender, and many of them are quitting the team because they are concerned for their safety. The district also said transgender students "have a legal right" to use the locker room "they gender identify with."

--In 2020, while Washington, D.C. allowed Black Lives Matter protesters to riot, loot and cause damage all summer long, the city did arrest two pro-life advocates for the "crime" of writing "Black Pre-Born Lives Matter" with chalk on a city sidewalk. A video of the arrest showed Warner DePriest and Erica Caporaletti saying "This is our Constitutional right." In partnership with Students for Life and the Frederick Douglass Foundation, they sued the city over a violation of their First Amendment rights and viewpoint discrimination. It took three years, but now a federal court has ruled unanimously that the city improperly arrested them.

"One month after Trump became president, February 2017, crude oil stood at \$67.62 a barrel. By July 2020, after ramped up production and

Selling our SPR to China? Who would do this? No one in their right mind, so far as a sensible reader can understand. Don't all presidents put Americans first? It is over, but Biden's judgment is 'bottom of the barrel,' his integrity absent, and motives – especially on China – plainly mixed. Bottom line: Trying to understand the web of Biden's unfolding lies, untold stories, and acts of misdirection – is a fulltime job – especially on China. Just keep your tank full, and eyes open."



Dr. Marc Siegel, Fox News medical analyst and Clinical Professor of Medicine at New York University, writing on "We need a nursing home for our aging leaders – not a Capitol or White House," in "The New York Post":

"Since there are no requirements that congressmen or presidents abdicate their positions voluntarily, I believe plans

should be made to support them. According to the Constitution, it would take a two-thirds vote of either house to remove a sitting lawmaker for disruptive behavior, so I don't expect to see that any time soon. As for the president, let's not use the dismissive term 'gaffe' to describe his periodic disorientation or massive mistakes about whether we have cured cancer or how many have died from COVID – but, no matter how much he shuffles or how many dangerous falls he takes while on blood thinners due to an irregular heart beat (atrial fibrillation), I don't expect to see the 25th Amendment

invoked to remove him. Meanwhile, it's just as disturbing to see Senator Dianne Feinstein's unelected aide telling her what to say on the Senate floor or how to vote. And on the other side of the aisle, we painfully watch Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell absolutely freeze in the middle of a speech for almost a minute. I have never examined him either, but he has sustained recent falls, and I have to wonder what an MRI of his brain would show. And then there's Senator John Fetterman, who certainly doesn't inspire confidence with his casual dress or his incoherent speech. But the real question is how much he comprehends when he goes to cast a vote or sponsor a bill. We don't know. But shouldn't we? Don't we, the American public, have a right to information about the fitness of our highest lawmakers or chief executive? Certainly, cognitive testing or MRIs of the brain will never be made a prerequisite to hold high office past a certain age, but this doesn't change the truth that, to properly represent the people who elected you, you must at least be coherent.... Unfortunately, this lack of transparency about officials' fitness for office is nothing new. Woodrow Wilson was hallucinating from the effects of the Spanish Flu when he met to sign the Treaty of Versailles, and Germany suffered more punishment at the hands of the British and the French as a result. Wilson later suffered a massive stroke while still in office, and the government was essentially run by his wife, though few outside his inner circle knew it. During FDR's last term, he was suffering from massive blood pressure elevations and ultimately died of cerebral hemorrhage. Again, only his inner circle knew about his condition. This kind of secrecy has also extended to Congress, where Senator Strom Thurmond became very sick in his last year before he died at 100, and Senator Robert Byrd continued serving into his 90s, despite several hospitalizations.... We can all relate to the courage of a sick or aging leader who fights on, refusing to 'go gentle into this good night.' Yet that doesn't mean they are the best people to be assessing their own fitness; just the opposite.... Perhaps a short stay in my proposed nursing home will help rejuvenate a failing senator or president, but better if they did us all a favor and just retired."

Xu Yanjun, a CCP intelligence officer, was convicted of trying to steal GE aviation technology for making jet engine blades.... In 2018, the 'China Initiative,' a national security program, was created to address CCP espionage in universities and research institutions. Harvard professor Charles Lieber, chair of the Chemical and Chemical Biology department, was prosecuted for concealing his affiliation with the Wuhan University of Technology, concealing his association with the CCP Thousand Talent recruitment program, and filing false income tax returns. Harvard's Lieber Research Group received over \$15 million in federal research grants from 2008 to 2018, while Lieber was receiving \$50,000 a month from Wuhan University plus \$1.5 million to establish a research lab at Wuhan. In other words, U.S. taxpayers were funding Harvard research that was then passed on to the CCP. Lieber did not report the CCP income on his tax forms and lied to federal authorities about his participation in the Thousand Talent program. Over the past three decades, the Los Alamos nuclear laboratory in New Mexico has seen over 160 researchers return to China to help with nuclear and advanced weapons systems.... 









